IHCP changes the blood factor maximum allowable cost multiplier

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) is changing the outpatient blood factor products maximum allowable cost (MAC) average acquisition cost (AAC) adjustment multiplier. The current multiplier used to establish outpatient blood factor MAC rates is 1.18. Effective for claims with dates of service (DOS) on or after

March 6, 2025, the multiplier will be 1.05. The multiplier for inpatient blood factor products MAC AAC will remain unchanged.

These changes will be reflected in the next regular update to Indiana Medicaid blood factor MAC rates, accessible from the Indiana fee-forservice (FFS) state maximum allowable cost (SMAC), Indiana FFS SMAC, page on the Optum Rx Indiana Medicaid website, accessible from the *Pharmacy Services* page at in.gov/medicaid/providers.

Carve out

As a reminder, blood factor products are carved out from managed care, which means that claims are processed through the FFS delivery system for all IHCP members. Blood factor product claims should be submitted as follows for both managed care and FFS members:



- Professional and institutional claims should be submitted to the FFS claim-processing contractor, Gainwell Technologies.
- Pharmacy claims should be submitted to the FFS pharmacy benefit manager, Optum Rx.
