IHCP provides clarification on CCBHC NPI enrollment for commercial and marketplace plans

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) published *IHCP Bulletin* [BT2024193](#) instructing certified community behavioral health clinic (CCBHC) providers on enrollment and billing requirements.

Specifically, providers enrolling as a CCBHC must obtain a unique National Provider Identifier (NPI) required for separate enrollment as a CCBHC, if the provider is already enrolled as a community mental health center (CMHC) (provider type 11, specialty 111) or federally qualified health center (FQHC) (provider type 08, specialty 080).



Managed care entities (MCEs) were instructed to deny any *claims* submitted from the eight CCBHC pilot site NPIs listed in Table 1.

However, the IHCP has discovered that MCEs, which also administer commercial and marketplace plans, are denying *provider enrollment* into their plans when providers use the unique NPI required for IHCP CCBHC enrollment.

The IHCP wants to provide crucial clarification – these CCBHC NPIs can be enrolled in the commercial and marketplace plans that the MCEs administer.

Health plans should **not** disallow enrollment for CCBHC NPIs when enrolling in their commercial or marketplace plans.

CCBHC services are carved out of Medicaid managed care. Medicaid [MCE](#) plans should deny claims received from a CCBHC provider (provider type 11, specialty 623). Claims from CCBHC providers with the provider specialty 623 should be submitted directly to Gainwell Technologies for reimbursement consideration.
