
# IHCP updates age range for physician-administered drug Lutathera (A9513)

In accordance with the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) is updating the age range requirements for Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) code A9513 – *Lutetium Lu 177 Dotatate (Lutathera)*.

Retroactive for dates of service on or after **April 1, 2024**, Lutathera can be prescribed to ages 12 and older. Prior to April 1, 2024, Lutathera could only be prescribed to ages 18 and older (see *IHCP Bulletin <u>BT202296</u>*).

The prior authorization (PA) criteria will be updated to the new age range in a future review of the <u>Oncology Services</u> provider reference module at in.gov/medicaid/providers.

If providers want to submit or resubmit any claims retroactively, they can submit claims within 90 days from the date of this publication for managed care claims, or 180 days of this publication date for fee-for-service (FFS) claims, to satisfy timely filing requirements. Providers should include a copy of this bulletin when submitting claims beyond the standard filing limit.
