IHCP adds coverage for CTA scan of blood vessels in the head and neck with contrast

Effective immediately, retroactive for dates of service (DOS) on or after **July 1, 2026**, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) is adding coverage to the medical benefit for computer tomographic angiography (CTA) scans of blood vessels in the head and neck, billed with Current Procedural Terminology (CPT^{®1}) code 70471 – *CT scan of blood vessels in the head and neck with contrast*.



IHCP coverage of this code applies to both managed care and fee-for-service (FFS) medical benefits.

These changes will be reflected in the next regular update to the Professional Fee Schedule and Outpatient Fee Schedule, accessible from the [IHCP Fee Schedules](#) webpage at in.gov/medicaid/providers.
