IHCP announces additional diagnosis codes for medical necessity of botulinum toxin injections

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) is updating its published table of ICD-10 diagnosis codes that support the medical necessity of botulinum toxin (botox) injections. Although not previously announced, the IHCP has accepted the diagnosis codes listed in Table 1 of this bulletin as valid diagnoses to support the medical necessity of botox injections since these codes were first introduced. Table 1 indicates the date of service (DOS) on or after which each of these codes is allowable for botox injection claims.

These diagnosis codes will be added to the *ICD-10 Diagnosis Codes for Medical Necessity of Botulinum Toxin Injections* table in *Injections, Vaccines, and Other Physician-Administered Drugs Codes*, accessible from the [Code Sets](https://in.gov/medicaid/providers) webpage at in.gov/medicaid/providers.

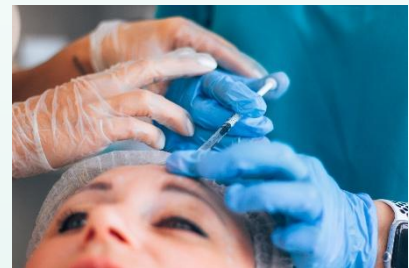


Table 1 – Additional (previously unannounced) diagnosis codes that support medical necessity of botox injections, effective for DOS on or after the date indicated

Diagnosis code	Code description	Effective date
G35A	Relapsing-remitting multiple sclerosis	Oct. 1, 2025
G35B0	Primary progressive multiple sclerosis, unspecified	Oct. 1, 2025
G35B1	Active primary progressive multiple sclerosis	Oct. 1, 2025
G35B2	Non-active primary progressive multiple sclerosis	Oct. 1, 2025
G35C0	Secondary progressive multiple sclerosis, unspecified	Oct. 1, 2025
G35C1	Active secondary progressive multiple sclerosis	Oct. 1, 2025
G35C2	Non-active secondary progressive multiple sclerosis	Oct. 1, 2025
G35D	Multiple sclerosis, unspecified	Oct. 1, 2025
G43E01	Chronic migraine with aura, not intractable, with status migrainosus	Oct. 1, 2023
G43E09	Chronic migraine with aura, not intractable, without status migrainosus	Oct. 1, 2023
G43E11	Chronic migraine with aura, intractable, with status migrainosus	Oct. 1, 2023
G43E19	Chronic migraine with aura, intractable, without status migrainosus	Oct. 1, 2023
