IHCP and DMHA to enforce service caps for Child Mental Health Wraparound program

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP), in coordination with the Division of Mental Health and Addiction (DMHA), is announcing the enforcement of existing service caps for certain services under the 1915(i) Medicaid Home- and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Child Mental Health Wraparound (CMHW) program.

Service limits will be enforced for the following Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) codes and code modifiers:



- H2014 HA – *Skills training and development, per 15 minutes; child mental health wraparound*
 - ⇒ This service is limited to 12 units (3 hours) per member per day and 120 units (30 hours) per member per month.
- H2015 HA – *Comprehensive community support services, per 15 minutes; CMHW services*
 - ⇒ This service is limited to 8 units (2 hours) per member per day. There is no annual limit.
- T1005 HA – *Unskilled Respite Care, not hospice; 15-minute units; Child Mental Health Wraparound services*
 - ⇒ This service is limited to 27 units (6 hours and 45 minutes) per member per day.

Fee-for-service (FFS) claims exceeding these daily or monthly limits will begin to deny, effective for dates of service (DOS) on or after **Aug. 1, 2025**. In addition, CMHW claims submitted for DOS between Aug. 1, 2025, and Aug. 1, 2026, will be mass adjusted. Providers should see adjusted claims on remittance advices (RAs) beginning Sept. 16, 2026, with internal control numbers (ICNs)/Claim IDs that begin with 52 (mass replacements non-check-related).
