IHCP corrects pricing method for certain procedure codes

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) discovered an error in which the pricing method for the procedure codes listed in Table 1 was inadvertently changed within the fee-for-service (FFS) claim-processing system. This error affected claims adjudicated between **April 1, 2026**, and **July 7, 2026**.

The FFS claim-processing system has been updated to reflect the correct pricing method for these codes, as indicated in Table 1. Providers can submit or resubmit FFS professional claims for these codes to the IHCP within 180 days from the date of this publication to satisfy timely filing requirements. Providers should include a copy of this bulletin (first page only) when submitting claims beyond the standard filing limit.



As a reminder, claims for procedure codes with a pricing method of SYSMAN (manually priced) must be submitted with appropriate pricing documentation, as indicated on the *Procedure Codes That Require Attachments* table, accessible from the [Code Sets](https://in.gov/medicaid/providers) webpage at in.gov/medicaid/providers. Such documentation is not required for procedure codes with a pricing method of BILL90, as they are reimbursed at 90% of the amount billed on the claim.
