Education and Workforce Development (EWD) is a collaborative initiative between MPH and the Indiana Department of Education, Commission for Higher Education, Department of Workforce Development, and the Family and Social Services Administration. Education and workforce data elements are linked across the partner agencies at the record level, joining key education and workforce descriptors for end user exploration.



EMPOWERING DECISION MAKERS

EWD provides end users, including the Governor's Workforce Cabinet and Career Connections and Talent, with the opportunity for a more holistic exploration of Indiana's education-to-workforce pipeline to address specific policy questions in the realm. This enhanced understanding enables decision makers to make better informed decisions to positively impact students, teachers, workers and employers.



ASSESSING INDIANA'S WORKFORCE NEEDS

Governor Eric Holcomb has prioritized the development of a 21st Century skilled and ready workforce. EWD allows educators, employers, policymakers, students, community leaders, and the general public to leverage data and information not previously available to enhance Indiana's workforce for the future.

EWD arms researchers and policymakers with actionable information about Indiana's education-to-workforce pipeline, providing valuable insight into the effects of policy change across K-12, higher education, and workforce, enabling data-driven decision making and data-informed policymaking.
