The Indiana Association for Community Economic Development (IACED) and the Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority (IHCDA) are already hard at work planning the 2014 Statewide Conference on Community Economic Development, which is set to take place September 30th & October 1st once again at the Marriott Indianapolis East (located off of 21st and Shadeland).

This is the tenth year for IACED and IHCDA to co-host the Statewide Conference on Housing and Community Economic Development. This partnership has proven fruitful by teaching the technical skills necessary to engage in community economic development work, and by supporting a culture of adaptive learning through the relationships participants build as a result of this conference and shared work.
