A review of the original RFI signed on November 4, 2022, for the above DES # indicated substantive changes have occurred within the 0.5 mile radius and/or project area limits that will have an impact to the project. Additional storm sewer and grading work will be completed along State Boulevard, from 550' west of Hillegas Road to Westgate Court. From State Boulevard south along Westgate Court to the Lowther Neuhaus Ditch. The Lowther Neuhaus Ditch will be used as an outfall. Excavation of this project is expected to be between 4' to 6'.

The following features and/or items were not detailed in the original RFI document (11-4-22), but have since been identified as having an impact on the project area and requiring additional coordination.

1. Water Resources -

IDEM 303d Listed Streams and Lakes (Impaired): An additional impaired stream intersects the project area. The Lowther Neuhaus Ditch intersects the project area approximately 800' east of Hillegas and 200' south of State Blvd. It is listed as impaired for E.coli, IBC, and is included in the St. Marys River and Maumee River Watershed TMDL.

- Concerning Impaired Biotic Communities (IBC), Best Management Practices (BMPs) will be used to avoid further degradation to the stream.
- Concerning Ecoli, workers who are working in or near water with E. coli should take care to wear appropriate PPE, observe proper hygiene procedures, including regular hand washing, and limit personal exposure.

Rivers and Streams: An additional river/stream segment intersect the project area. The Lowther Neuhaus Ditch intersects the project area approximately 800' east of Hillegas and 200' south of State Blvd. This will affect the project. A Waters of the US Report is recommended based on mapped features, and coordination with the appropriate agency, if applicable, will occur.

Floodplain – **DFIRM:** Two (2) additional floodplain polygons intersect the project area approximately 800' east of Hillegas and 200' south of State Blvd and is associated with the Lowther Neuhaus Ditch. This will affect the project. Coordination with the appropriate agency will occur.

2. Hazardous Material Concerns -

NPDES Facilities: Two (2) additional NPDES facilities are located adjacent to the project area.

- The NPDES Facility named "Finnegan's Playground Indoor Dog Park", permit number INRA06772 is located at 3232 Hillegas Rd. The permit was issued on 12/29/2020 and expires 12/29/2025. Coordination with Finnegan's Playground Indoor Dog Park will occur.
- The NPDES Facility named "Zurcher Tire New Warehouse", permit number INRA10457 is located at 3414 Hillegas Rd. The permit was issued on 9/6/2022 and expires 9/5/2027. Coordination with Zurcher Tire New Warehouse will occur.


3. Ecological Information -

The Allen County listing of the Indiana Natural Heritage Data Center information on endangered, threatened, or rare (ETR) species and high quality natural communities is provided at https://www.in.gov/dnr/nature-preserves/files/np_allen.pdf. A preliminary review of the Indiana Natural Heritage Database did not indicate the presence of ETR species within the 0.5 mile search radius. Coordination with USFWS and IDNR will occur.

A review of the USFWS database (by INDOT Fort Wayne District dated 1/8/2024) did not indicate the presence of endangered bat species in or within 0.25 miles of the project area. The range-wide programmatic consultation for the Indiana Bat and Northern Long-eared Bat shall be completed according to the most recent "Using the USFWS's IPaC System for Listed Bat Consultation for INDOT Projects".

	This project is on Hillegas Road, with the beginning of the RFI at California Road to (south of) Leesburg Road. The construction of this project will be from Coliseum Boulevard to State Boulevard. The project will add travel lanes that include curb and gutter on both sides with an underground storm sewer system to address drainage on the roadway. The roadway will consist of four (4) eleven (11) foot travel lanes, with left turn lanes at intersections as needed. A ten (10) foot trail on the east side and a five (5) foot sidewalk on the west side of the roadway is proposed. There will be a six (6) foot grass buffer between trail/sidewalk and curb line. In addition to the trails and sidewalks, curb ramps will be installed at all intersections.

Religious Facilities: One (1) religious facility is located within the 0.5 mile radius. Three Rivers Wesleyan Church, located at 2825 Hillegas Rd, is adjacent to the west side of the project area 0.05 miles south of Butler Road. Coordination with Three Rivers Wesleyan Church will occur.

Airports: Although not located within the 0.5 mile search radius, one (1) public airport, Smith Field Airport, is located within 3.8 miles (20,000 feet) of the project area. The public-use airport is located approximately 2.35 miles northeast of the project area; therefore, early coordination with INDOT Aviation will occur.

Recreational Facilities: One (1) recreational facility is located within the 0.5 mile radius. The closest recreational facility, Coyote Creek Golf Course (listed in GIS as Ft. Wayne Elks Lodge 155 Golf Course), is approximately 0.08 miles north of the project area. No impact is expected.

Trails: Three (3) potential trails are located within the 0.5 mile search radius. One (1) potential trail is located adjacent to or within the project area. This trail segment is located on the east side of Hillegas Road from Coliseum Boulevard to State Boulevard. Coordination with City of Fort Wayne Public Works and City of Fort Wayne Greenways Manager will occur.

NWI-Lines: Five (5) NWI-Lines are located within the 0.5 mile search radius. One (1) NWI-Line intersects the project approximately 0.08 miles north of Clearview Dr. A Waters of the US Report is recommended and coordination with the appropriate agency, if applicable, will occur.

IDEM 303d Listed Streams and Lakes (Impaired): Four (4) impaired streams are located within the 0.5 mile search radius. Two (2) impaired streams intersect the project.

- Natural Drain #6, an unnamed tributary of Spy Run Creek, intersects the project area approximately 0.04 miles north of Coliseum Blvd. It is listed as impaired for Ecoli and IBC.
 - o Concerning Impaired Biotic Communities (IBC), Best Management Practices (BMPs) will be used to avoid further degradation to the stream.
 - Concerning Ecoli, workers who are working in or near water with E. coli should take care to wear appropriate PPE, observe proper hygiene procedures, including regular hand washing, and limit personal exposure.
- Prange Drain, a tributary of Spy Run Creek, intersects the project area approximately 0.08 miles north of Clearview Dr. It is listed as impaired for Ecoli and IBC.
 - o Concerning Impaired Biotic Communities (IBC), Best Management Practices (BMPs) will be used to avoid further degradation to the stream.
 - Concerning Ecoli, workers who are working in or near water with E. coli should take care to wear appropriate PPE, observe proper hygiene procedures, including regular hand washing, and limit personal exposure.

Rivers and Streams: Nine (9) river/stream segments are located within the 0.5 mile search radius. Three (3) river/stream segments intersect the project area. A Waters of the US Report is recommended and coordination with the appropriate agency, if applicable, will occur.

- Natural Drain #6, an unnamed tributary of Spy Run Creek, intersects the project approximately 0.04 miles north of Coliseum Blvd.
- Prange Drain, a tributary of Spy Run Creek, intersects the project approximately 0.08 miles north of Clearview Dr.
- Sargent Drain intersects the project area approximately 0.18 miles north of State Blvd.

NWI – *Wetlands:* Forty-three (43) wetlands are located within the 0.5 mile search radius. One (1) potential wetland is located adjacent to the project area approximately 540' north of Superior Ridge Dr on the east side of Hillegas Rd. It is a newly constructed drainage basin that could be a potential wetland. A Waters of the US Report is recommended and coordination with the appropriate agency, if applicable, will occur.

Lakes: Seven (7) lakes are located within the 0.5 mile search radius. The closest lake is located approximately 0.18 miles east of the project area. No impact is expected.

Floodplain – DFIRM: Twenty-two (22) floodplain polygons are located within the 0.5 mile search radius. Two (2) are located adjacent to or within the project area. Coordination with the appropriate agency, if applicable, will occur.

- One is associated with Natural Drain #6, an unnamed tributary of Spy Run Creek that intersects the project approximately 0.04 miles north of Coliseum Blvd. The floodplain polygon intersects the project area 0.03 miles east of the intersection of Coliseum Blvd and Hillegas Rd.
- One is associated with Prange Drain, a tributary of Spy Run Creek, which intersects the project approximately 0.08 miles north of Clearview Dr.

Explanation:

RCRA Generator/ TSD Sites: Two (2) RCRA Generator/ TSDs are located within the 0.5 mile search radius. One (1) RCRA Generator/ TSD is located 0.06 miles east of the project area. Fort Wayne Public Television Incorporated located at 3632 Butler Rd has property adjacent to the project. It has an Agency Interest ID 109. In April 28, 2003, IDEM indicated that an EPA ID Number was no longer needed for this site. No impact is expected.

Underground Storage Tank (UST) Sites: Ten (10) USTs are located within the 0.5 mile search radius. Two (2) USTs are located adjacent to the project area.

- One (1) UST site was located at Federal Express Corporation at 3620 Independence Dr approximately 160' east of Hillegas Rd's current centerline. The Agency Interest ID is 14940. The UST was closed in 2016. IDEM issued a No Further Action Approval Determination Pursuant to Remediation Closure Guide on July 26, 2017. No contaminant detections exceeded the residential direct contact levels for Soil. Vapor Intrusion did not exceed the vapor intrusion levels. Lead exceeded the tap water screening level at 596 ug/L in the ground water within the former tank basin. All of the source was removed and the residual lead contamination in the ground water was limited to the former UST basin. The residual contamination is located in a shallow, low-conductivity zone that is unlikely to be used for a drinking water source. The closure is unconditional for soil, groundwater, and vapor intrusion exposures. No impact is expected.
- One (1) of the USTs is located at Phil's #11 at 3005 Hillegas Rd, AI ID 109723. IDEM conducted a UST inspection on January 23, 2019, and the facility was found to be out of compliance with equipment, operating, and maintenance requirements set forth in Indiana's UST Rule 329 IAC 9. IDEM issued a Return to Compliance Letter on November 27, 2019. No impact is expected.

Voluntary Remediation Program: Two (2) Voluntary Remediation Program sites are located within the 0.5 mile search radius. The closest site is located approximately 0.20 miles east of the project area. No impact is expected.

Leaking Underground Storage (LUST) Sites: Five (5) LUST sites are located within the 0.5 mile search radius. One (1) LUST is located adjacent to the project area. The Fort Wayne Baptist Temple was once located at 3200 Hillegas Rd but no longer exists. The Agency Interest ID is 557. The LUST was removed in 1996. IDEM issued a No Further Action letter on August 7, 1997. No impact is expected. Valu Lodge (now Hoosier Inn Extended Stay), 3527 Coliseum Drive, AI ID #2287, is located 0.07 mile east-northeast of the project area. IDEM issued a No Further Action Approval Determination Pursuant to Remediation Closure Guide on April 7, 2014. The closure was unconditional for soil, groundwater, and vapor intrusion exposures. No impact is expected.

Brownfields: One (1) Brownfield site is located within the 0.5 mile search radius. The closest site is mapped approximately 0.43 miles east of the project area; however, it is located 0.50 mile east of the project area. No impact is expected.

Institutional Controls: Two (2) Institutional Control sites are located within the 0.5 mile search radius. The closest site is located approximately 0.48 miles east of the project area. No impact is expected.

NPDES Facilities: Ten (10) NPDES Facilities are located within the 0.5 mile search radius. Three (3) NPDES Facilities are located adjacent to the project area.

- Hillegas Road Over I-69 Bridge Rehabilitation, permit number INR10N917 is located at the north end of the project. The permit was issued on 5/20/2017 and expired on 5/19/2022. No impact is expected.
- Hull Lift Truck, at 3780 Hillegas Rd, permit number INR10P183 is located adjacent to the north end of the project. The permit was issued on 6/30/2017 and expired 6/29/2022. No impact is expected.
- New Building and Site for Evapar, at 3810 Hillegas Rd, permit number INR10H477 is located adjacent to the north end of the project. The permit was issued on 10/25/2013 and expired on 10/24/2018. No impact is expected.

NPDES Pipe Locations: One (1) NPDES Pipe location is located within the 0.5 mile search radius. The closest site is located approximately 0.32 miles east of the project area. No impact is expected.

Natural Drain #6, an unnamed tributary of Spy Run Creek, intersects the project approximately 0.04 miles north of Coliseum Blvd., and Prange Drain, a tributary of Spy Run Creek, intersects the project approximately 0.08 miles north of Clearview Dr. Both streams are listed as impaired for E. coli and IBC.
 - o Concerning IBC, BMPs will be used to avoid further degradation to the stream.
 - Concerning E. coli, workers who are working in or near water with E. coli should take care to wear appropriate PPE, observe proper hygiene procedures, including regular hand washing, and limit personal exposure.
- Rivers and Streams: Three (3) river/stream features intersect the project area. A Waters of the US Report is recommended and coordination with the appropriate agency, if applicable, will occur.
 - Natural Drain #6, an unnamed tributary of Spy Run Creek, intersects the project approximately 0.04 miles north of Coliseum Blvd.

 - One floodplain is associated with Prange Drain, a tributary of Spy Run Creek, and intersects the project area approximately 0.08 miles north of Clearview Dr.
