

**Ped, Pedal & Paddle Committee Meeting
NIRPC Lake Michigan Room
November 5, 2020**

This Ped, Pedal & Paddle (3PC) meeting was convened as an electronic meeting, pursuant to Governor Holcomb's Executive Order 20-04 and 20-09, extended by Executive Order 20-47. All persons were meeting remotely on a Google Meet platform that allowed for real time interaction and supported the public's ability to observe and record the proceedings. When the agenda item was provided for public comment, this was supported as well. A roll call was taken to motion and approve the agenda items.

Mitch Barloga called the meeting to order at 1:36 p.m.

The minutes of the August 6, 2020 meeting were approved on a motion by John Novacich and a second by Donna Catalano.

Review of NOFA Applications

Mitch Barloga reviewed the 2020 Notice of Funding Applications (NOFA) for Multi-use Trails, and Complete Streets submissions. There was a total of 13 submitted projects from 11 communities. Mitch reviewed the project scoring for each of the following projects. However, Michigan City was slated for the January 5, 2021 3PC meeting. The scoring changes that were discussed and agreed on by the committee were made live by Mitch. Supporting documentation will be sent to Mitch Barloga. match commitment can be changed up until January.

Multi-Use Trails Submissions - Lake & Porter Counties

- Burns Harbor - Marquette Greenway Bridge over NFS Tracks. Funding request is \$3,000,000. The self-score of 66 was adjusted by NIRPC staff to 69. The 3PC score was 68.
- Cedar Lake - Founders Creek Multi-Use Trail. Funding request is \$1,287,440. The self-score of 60 was adjusted by NIRPC staff to 57. The 3PC score was 58.
- Crown Point - Pennsy Greenway to Veterans Trail. Funding request is \$2,145,600. The self-score of 73 was adjusted by NIRPC staff to 72. The 3PC score was 74.
- Dyer - Pennsy-Dyer Trail. Funding request is \$915,200. The self-score of 52 was adjusted by NIRPC staff to 55. The 3PC score was also 55.
- Hammond
 - Marquette Greenway - Kennedy to Cline. Funding request is \$1,600,000. The self-score of 75 was adjusted by NIRPC staff to 69. The 3PC score was also 69.
 - Marquette Greenway Bridge over Kennedy. Funding request is \$567,520. The self-score of 73 was adjusted by NIRPC staff to 70. The 3PC score was also 70.
- Lake County - C&O Trail. Funding request is \$663,300. The self-score of 63 was adjusted by NIRPC staff to 60. The 3PC score was 61.
- Merrillville - C&O Greenway Phase III. Funding request is \$1,332,000. The self-score of 72 was adjusted by NIRPC staff to 53. The 3PC score was 58.
- St. John - Town Pathways. Funding request is \$1,979,000. The self-score of 64 was adjusted by NIRPC staff to 61. The 3PC score was also 61.

- Valparaiso - TOD Pathways. Funding request is \$1,360,460. The self-score of 70 was adjusted by NIRPC staff to 69. The 3PC score was 74.

Multi-Use Trails Submissions - LaPorte County

- LaPorte County - Lincoln Trail Extension to PNW. Funding request is \$1,451,214. The self-score of 74 was adjusted by NIRPC staff to 53. The 3PC score was 52.
- Michigan City - Tabled for the January 5, 2021 meeting. A revised application will be submitted.
 - Singing Sands Phase III - Segments A & C. Funding request is 1,984,716. The self-score of 77 was adjusted by NIRPC staff to 76. 3PC score pending.
 - Singing Sands Phase III - Segment D. Funding request is \$1,456,740. The self-score of 70 was adjusted by NIRPC staff to 70. 3PC score pending.

Complete Streets Submission

- Cedar Lake - Lake Shore Drive Corridor Sidewalk Project. Funding request is 2,353,650. The self-score of 51 was adjusted by NIRPC staff to 53. The 3PC score was also 53.
