### What is NIRPC?

- Creation of the Federal Government to coordinate use of highway and public transit funding
- Designated as a Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) by Governor (Defines responsibilities for planning and programming of transportation funds)
- Designated as a Council of Governments by state law (limits members to elected officials only)
- Same state law added duties to include environmental and economic development planning.

## WHO IS NIRPC

- Every City and Town in Lake, Porter and La Porte Counties has one appointment
- Every County Council and Board of Commissioners has one appointment
- All 3 County Surveyors have an appointment
- The Porter County Townships of Union and Porter each have an appointment
- The Governor has one appointment
- The Transit Operators have one appointment

# HOW ARE DECISIONS MADE AT NIRPC?

- Citizen Working Groups and Task Forces are formed to make recommendations to the Commission's Policy Committees
- Standing Policy Committees are Transportation, Environmental Planning, and Economic Development
- Standing Policy Committees make final recommendations to NIRPC Board of Commissioners

# HOW PUBLIC BUS AND DEMAND RESPONSE TRANSIT ARE FUNDED IN NORTHWEST INDIANA

- Federal Support from Federal Transit Administration (FTA Section 5307 Funds)
- State Support (Line item in budget, previously Public Mass Transit Fund from sales tax)
- Local Support from fares, municipal property taxes, other federal programs, county economic development income tax, county budgets (property taxes)


