Under [IC 4-22-2-24](#), notice is hereby given that on June 25, 2024, at 5:30 p.m., at the Fort Harrison State Park Inn, 5830 North Post Road, Roosevelt Ballroom, Indianapolis, Indiana, the Natural Resources Commission (commission) will hold a public hearing on amendments to [312 IAC 9-3-18.2](#) to allow an individual to trap river otter anywhere in the state, and establish a statewide quota for the river otter trapping season.

The purpose of this hearing is to receive comments from the public prior to consideration of adoption of these rules by the commission. All interested persons are invited and will be given reasonable opportunity to express their views concerning the proposed rule amendments.

This notice is the second of two public hearings in which the public may comment on the proposed rule. Following the second public comment period and this public hearing, the commission may adopt a version of the proposed rule that is the same as or does not substantially differ from the text of the proposed rule published in the Notice of Second Public Comment Period.
