

Recovery Housing Program

The Recovery Housing Program provides funding to support stable, transitional housing for individuals in recovery from a substance use disorder.

Eligible Activities

The following activities are eligible for RHP funding:

- Acquisition & disposition of real property
- Rehabilitation or construction of recovery residences that meet standards levels 2, 3 or 4 from the National Alliance of Recovery Residences (NARR)
- Administration
- Lease, rent and utilities
- Clearance and demolition

Funding Details

- \$5,000 cap per beneficiary has been waived
- Restrictions on open CDBG grants has been waived
- Maximum grant allocation is \$750,000

Who Can Apply?

Lead applicants must be an entitlement city, non-entitlement city, county or incorporated town that possesses the legal capacity to carry out the proposed program.

The lead applicant may contract with a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization to carry out the activities of an eligible project.

All grant administrators for CDBG projects must be certified by OCRA. Find OCRA's list of certified GAs and our CDBG Grant Administrator Certification Policy at ocra.in.gov.

National Objective

RHP projects must benefit a limited clientele whose population is at least 51% low- and moderate-income.
