Gabriel (Gabe) Paul graduated from Indiana University in 1995 with a B.A. in Communications and History and with a J.D. from the Maurer School of Law at Indiana University in 1999. He served in the private sector before joining the State of Indiana as a Staff Attorney for the Indiana Department of Transportation in 2006. From 2013-2021, Gabe was appointed by Governor Mike Pence as the Director and Chief ALJ of the State Employees' Appeals Commission, which heard grievances concerning state employees. In 2021, Governor Holcomb appointed Gabe to his current role as the Chairman of the Indiana Unemployment Insurance Review Board, which hears unemployment insurance appeals from lower level agency ALJs and serves as the final agency authority for such appeals.

Gabe has also served as a past president of the Indiana Association of Administrative Law Judges (INAALJ) and has served on the Board of Directors of the National Association of Administrative Law Judiciary (NAALJ) since 2019. In October, 2022, Gabe was elected as President-elect of NAALJ starting in October, 2023.
