On behalf of the Region, City, County, Indiana, and with the full endorsement of the Greenfield City Council, I am pleased to submit this Letter of Intent to formally pursue Tier 1 “Nuclear Ready” designation under the Indiana Advanced Nuclear Ready Communities Program administered by the Indiana Office of Energy Development.
