RULE READOPTION

Re: LSA #14-399

898 IAC 1-3-1 This rule establishes fees for Athletic Trainers Board.

(1) Continued need for the rule: The Indiana General Assembly has charged the Board with the duty to adopt rules establishing standards for the competent practice of medicine, osteopathic medicine, or any other form of practice regulated by a limited license or permit issued under this article. This rule is needed for the Board to satisfy this mandate from the legislature.

(2) Nature of complaints or comments received from the public or small businesses concerning the rule or its implementation by the agency: The Board has received no complaints nor comments concerning this rule.

(3) The complexity of the rule, including any difficulties encountered by the agency in administering the rule or small businesses in complying with the rule: Staff and the Board have had no difficulty administering the rule or small businesses in complying with the rule.

(4) The extent to which the rule duplicates or conflicts with other federal, state, or local laws, rules, regulations, or ordinances: This rule does not duplicate nor conflict with other federal, state or local laws, rules, regulations or ordinances.

(5) The length of time since the rule was last reviewed under this section or otherwise evaluated by the agency, and the degree to which technology, economic conditions, or other factors have changed in the area affected by the rule since that time: The Board last reviewed the rule in 2008. There has been no change to technology, economic conditions or other factors affecting this rule since that time.
