College Level Examination Program. These 'test' out exams can be approved and acceptable. The course must be approved, and certain passing levels are required to be accepted. The board will consider the passing level Purdue, an Indiana institution, requires in its assessment of whether to find a test an acceptable alternative to taking a course.

2. Rule Change Discussion

Greg Morical referenced the most recent draft with proposed red lined changes and modifications. The current version of the draft, proposed changes will be distributed with the meeting materials for the next board meeting.

Discussion about technology degrees and the education requirements associated with them. Sam Reed did bring up the structural engineer license. Not all disciplines are equal in the PE world. There could be merit for a group to analyze alternative pathways to licensure, what kind of technology is required, how much experience would be required.

The board discussed forming an ad hoc committee to develop a proposed scope for a study of different disciplines and the associated technology degrees with to compare the two and see where there are differences and deficiencies, study these and attempt to determine alternative paths.
