1. Alternative Pathways to Licensure

Sam has no new updates on this topic. One third of the states in the country have incorporated a technology degree which is ABET accredited, though Indiana's course requirements and the content required for licensure varies so greatly. ABET accredited degrees may not require further, deeper review though the rules would have to be modified
