**IV. INDIANA STATE NURSES ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (ISNAP) REPORT**

Charles Lindquist, ISNAP Program Director, presented the monthly report to the Board. Mr. Lindquist informed the Board that ISNAP has, as of March, 2006, 438 active clients, 26 new intakes, 78 intakes in process and 27 RMA's returned. Mr. Lindquist informed the Board of the next provider meeting, which is April 25, 2006 at St. Joseph Hospital in Fort Wayne. Sgt. Don McCay with the Indiana State Police will be speaking on the methamphetamine culture.
