XIII. ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE RECOMMENDATIONS (TO BE APPROVED)

The following personal appearances took place on April 8th, 2015 before ALJ Linda Narwold, RN.; A motion was made and seconded to accept the personal appearances conducted on April 8, 2015. Laux/Smith, 5-0-0, motion carries

A. For Licensure

1. Lisa Farley RN Exam Four Failed Attempts
Ms. Farley appeared for her personal appearance regarding her application for licensure. Ms. Farley has taken the NCLEX four times and graduated in 2012. She works as an LPN. She waited so long between her last review course and taking the test because she was dealing with some personal issues. She believes she has extreme test anxiety. Ms. Narwold recommends the following: She needs to take a refresher course with a clinical component. Once that is done she needs to see a counselor regarding the test anxiety. She also needs to take a review course. She must submit documentation from the review course showing she has at least a 95% chance or greater of passing the NCLEX. Once all this has been completed she will be allowed to test and license to be issued free and clear
2. Karly Barton RN Exam Four Failed Attempts
Karly Barton appeared for a personal appearance on April 8, 2015. Ms. Barton applied for an RN license by examination. She failed the NCLEX four times. She graduated May of 2014 from Indiana University East. She took the exam four times. She took the Hurst review course in May and the ATI which was required by the school. She also purchased review books to study. She went to the doctor for medication for anxiety. Ms. Narwold recommends that Ms. Barton takes the ATI review. She must have a 95% probability of passing. She must take the exam within two weeks of the ATI. If she does not pass the NCLEX the 5th time, she will be required to go back to school. Once she passes the NCLEX, she can be issued free and clear.
3. Melissa Copeland RN Exam Grad Date of May 2009
Melissa Copeland appeared for a personal appearance on April 8, 2015. Ms. Copeland applied for an RN license by examination. She graduated in May of 2009. She took the Kaplan course. She completed it March of 2015 with a 95% probability of passing. Ms. Narwold recommends that Ms. Copeland take a refresher course with a clinical component. Once she completes the refresher course, she may sit for the exam. She may be issued free and clear upon passing the NCLEX.

4. Regina Doriety RN Exam Four Failed Attempts
Regina Doriety appeared for a personal appearance on April 8, 2015. Ms. Doriety applied for an RN license by examination. She graduated from ITT Tech September of 2012. She failed the NCLEX four times. She is currently taking a Kaplan review course. She has taken it once before with a 97% probability of passing. She had a death in her family and she was unable to focus. She plans on going to the doctor for text anxiety. She is currently working as a patient care taker at St. James Hospital in Illinois. Ms. Narwold recommends that Ms. Doriety takes a refresher course with a clinical component and to continue her Kaplan course. She must provide the board a 95% probability of passing before she is eligible to sit for the exam. She may be issued free and clear upon passing the NCLEX.
5. Laci Littrell RN Exam Four Failed Attempts*
Personal appearance vacated. Laci Littrell requested to withdraw her license application.
6. Tashema Webb LPN Exam Grad Date of March 2011
Tashema Webb failed to appear for a personal appearance and will be rescheduled.
7. Yolondia Barksdale RN Exam Five Failed Attempts
Yolondia Barksdale appeared for a personal appearance on April 8, 2015. Ms. Barksdale applied for an RN license by examination. She graduated from Purdue University. She failed the NCLEX exam five times. She did a live review in March of 2015. She is currently in the virtual ATI. She is struggling with test anxiety and is on medication. She is currently working as an LPN. Ms. Narwold recommends that Ms. Barksdale completes the virtual ATI with a 95% probability of passing. If she fails the 6th time, she will be required to go back to school. She may be issued free and clear upon passing the NCLEX.

B. For Renewal

1. Margaret Hawes LPN Exp Renewal Positive Response*
Margaret Hawes appeared for a personal appearance on April 8, 2015. She answered "Yes" to question 3 and 7 on her renewal application. She recently lost her husband and was prescribed medication and sleeping pills. She had been drinking while on the medication and got into her car. She fell asleep behind the wheel. She drove into oncoming traffic and was struck on the passenger side. She was charged with a D Felony. Ms. Linda Narwold recommends that she receives an ISNAP evaluation. If she is eligible, she must sign an RMA. She may be renewed on probation. Her license may be renewed on probation for the length of the RMA.
2. Gail Gray RN Exp Renewal Positive Response
Gail Gray appeared for a personal appearance on April 8, 2015. Ms. Gray answered "Yes" to question 3 on her renewal application. Ms. Gray was on active duty for the military. She owned some property and her husband decided to lease it out. The individual who rented it was selling alcohol without a license. She was charged for public nuisance because she owned the property. She refused to take a plea bargain. She goes to court tomorrow to set for a trial. Ms. Narwold recommends that she is renewed free and clear.
3. Tiffany Wade LPN Exp Renewal Failed to Submit Statement
Tiffany Wade appeared for a personal appearance on April 8, 2015. Ms. Wade answered "Yes" to question 5 on her renewal application. She failed to submit a statement. The incident happened in 2010, she was sexually assaulted. The person forced her to take medication from the hospital she was working at. After taking the medication, she reported it to her boss and she was terminated. It was reported to the board. She is receiving counseling and is on medication. She has not been working in Nursing since then. She has been focusing on her two children the last few years. Ms. Narwold recommends that Ms. Wade takes a refresher course with a clinical component.
4. Marie Wilson LPN Exp Renewal Positive Response
Marie Wilson appeared for a personal appearance on April 8, 2015. Her license is currently on probation. She originally came to the board and was required to do continuing education in a certain time period. The continuing education was not completed within the 30 days. The remaining continuing education was received and fulfilled. Ms. Narwold recommends that her license is renewed on probation.
5. Christina Ramon RN Exp Renewal Positive Response
Christina Ramon failed to appear for a personal appearance and will be rescheduled.
6. Leslie Carthan LPN Exp Renewal Failed to Submit Statement
Leslie Carthan failed to appear for a personal appearance and will be rescheduled.

7. Marc Cornett RN Exp Renewal Failed to Submit CEUs/Current License
Marc Cornett failed to appear for a personal appearance and will be rescheduled.

8. Lisa Devero RN Exp Renewal Expired Over 10 Years CONTINUED

9. Courtney Kenney LPN Exp Renewal Positive Response*

Courtney Kenney appeared for a personal appearance on April 8, 2015. She applied to reinstate her expired LPN license and answered "Yes" to question 1. She was charged with possession of marijuana. She allowed her boyfriend and her sister to stay at her house. Her front door was broken. She left to go purchase the tools to fix it. When she returned, the cops were there to check up on house because they were suspicious because they saw someone messing with her front door. The cops smelled marijuana and searched the house. They found marijuana and she was charged. She violated her criminal probation because drank a glass of wine. She called her probation officer to admit that she drank. She spent 10 weekends in jails. She was terminated in July of 2014 because poor work performance. She just had a baby and was having trouble juggling home and work. She has not worked since. She has been staying at home with her child. Ms. Narwold recommends that her license is renewed free and clear.

10. Jennifer Graves APN/CSR Exp Renewal Positive Response

Jennifer Graves appeared for a personal appearance on April 8, 2015. Counsel Lorie Brown was present. Ms. Graves answered "yes" on her renewal because her license was disciplined by Oklahoma. She was writing prescriptions for inmates. She was working at a correctional facility. Oklahoma does not allow prescriptive authority without a Masters Degree. She let her employer know that she did not have a Masters Degree but they assured her that she can still write prescriptions. Before she terminated, her employer sent her to another jail to write prescription for inmates but her doctor was not at the location. When she met with the investigators, they recommended that she paid a fine, do continuing education, could not apply for prescriptive authority for 5 years. They never suspended or revoked her license. In Texas, it was an order to take a jurisprudence class when they saw that she was disciplined in Oklahoma. Her license in Texas is free and clear. She also has a New Mexico and Kentucky license. They are free and clear. She went to Purdue in 1986 and graduated in 2003 from the Nurse Practitioner program. It was not a masters but a certificate. She now enrolled to obtain her Masters. Ms. Narwold recommends that Ms. Graves is renewed free and clear.
