New Reciprocity Licensure for Additional Health Care Professionals beginning Monday, December 12, 2022

Indianapolis, IN – The Indiana Professional Licensing Agency (IPLA) is pleased to announce that additional health care professionals now have a new means to apply for licensure through reciprocity in the state of Indiana. This is the third and final phase of the IPLA's rollout and implementation of licensure through reciprocity for health care professionals under the requirements of Indiana Code § 25-1-21.

Beginning Monday, December 12, 2022, this new reciprocity licensure will be available to the following professions/license types:
