IV. INDIANA STATE NURSES ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Mr. Lindquist addressed the Board. ISNAP has hired a replacement for Roxanne Thomas as of October 1, 2012. ISNAP's model will be shifting to include 4 case managers so the average case load will decrease from 250 to 135 for participants in the program. Mr. Lindquist reported 39 new intakes and 26 closures this month.

V. EDUCATION

A. Harrison College- Request for Additional ASN Cohort

Staff from Harrison College was present to discuss their request for ASN program. They currently enroll one time a year and they would like to enroll in April as well. They have multiple clinical sites, are now NLNAC accredited and feel the time is right to do so. They have an additional faculty hire coming on in November and will have an additional hire prior to April. All current faculty is masters prepared.
