

RABIES VACCINATION



 Rabies is NOT a disease of the past:
~60,000 people worldwide die EVERY YEAR from rabies infection.

 Bats are the most common source in Indiana. IN Department of Health tests 400-500 bats each year after exposing humans or animals—often INSIDE a home.

 Exposure includes: bite by a bat; waking up in a room with a bat; a child or incapacitated person in a room with a bat; an animal with a bat in its mouth or fighting or killing a bat.
