Pursuant to Indiana Code 4-22, as the Small Business Ombudsman for the state of Indiana, I have reviewed the proposed rule and economic impact analysis for small businesses associated with the rule changes contained in LSA Document #23-43 (proposed rule) proposed by the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency (PLA), Indiana State Board of Nursing, and found the following to be true.

Proposed rule LSA #23-43 provides a review process and identifies convictions which may be a cause for concern and result in a person that is seeking licensure as a registered nurse to be denied the applicable license or disqualify licensure. The proposed rule change appears to be done so in the least stringent and most efficient way possible, and will have a minimal, if any, direct impact to small businesses across the state of Indiana.

Based upon this statement and review, the Indiana Small Business Ombudsman supports the proposed rule related to the economic impact to small business if the PLA conclusion reflects the actual result after promulgation.
