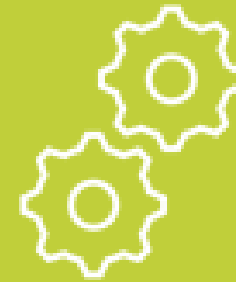

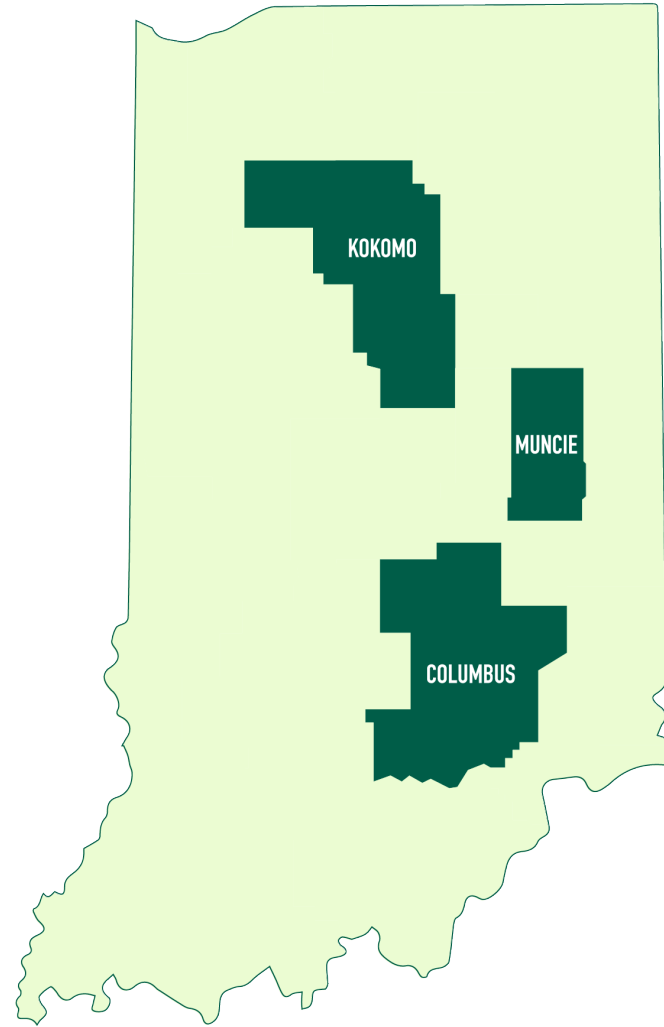

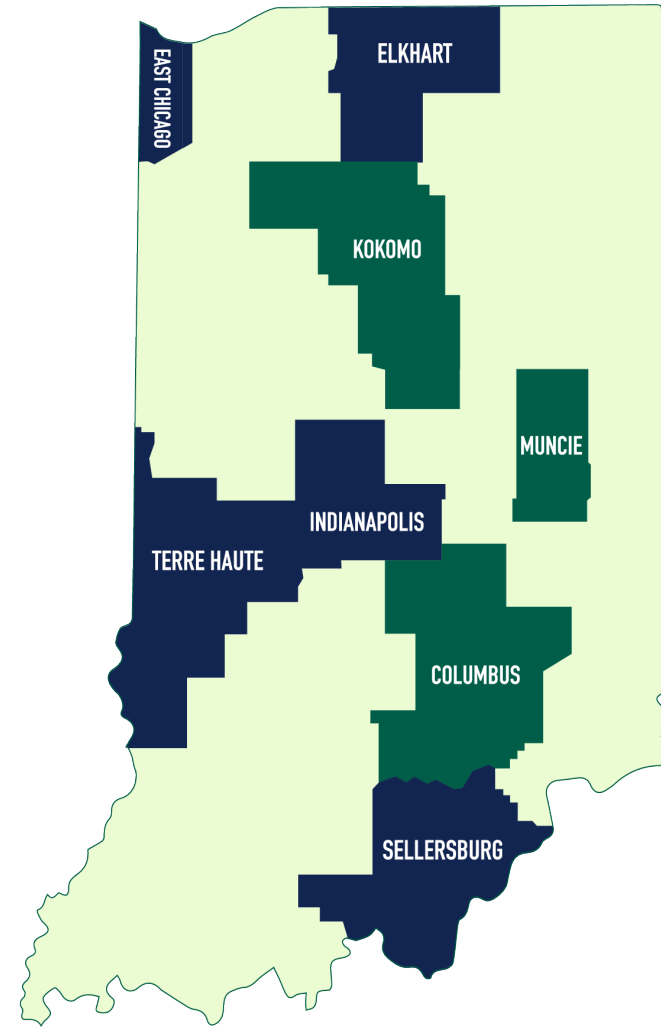
Capital

More than half of Ivy Tech students are above the traditional college age of 18–21.



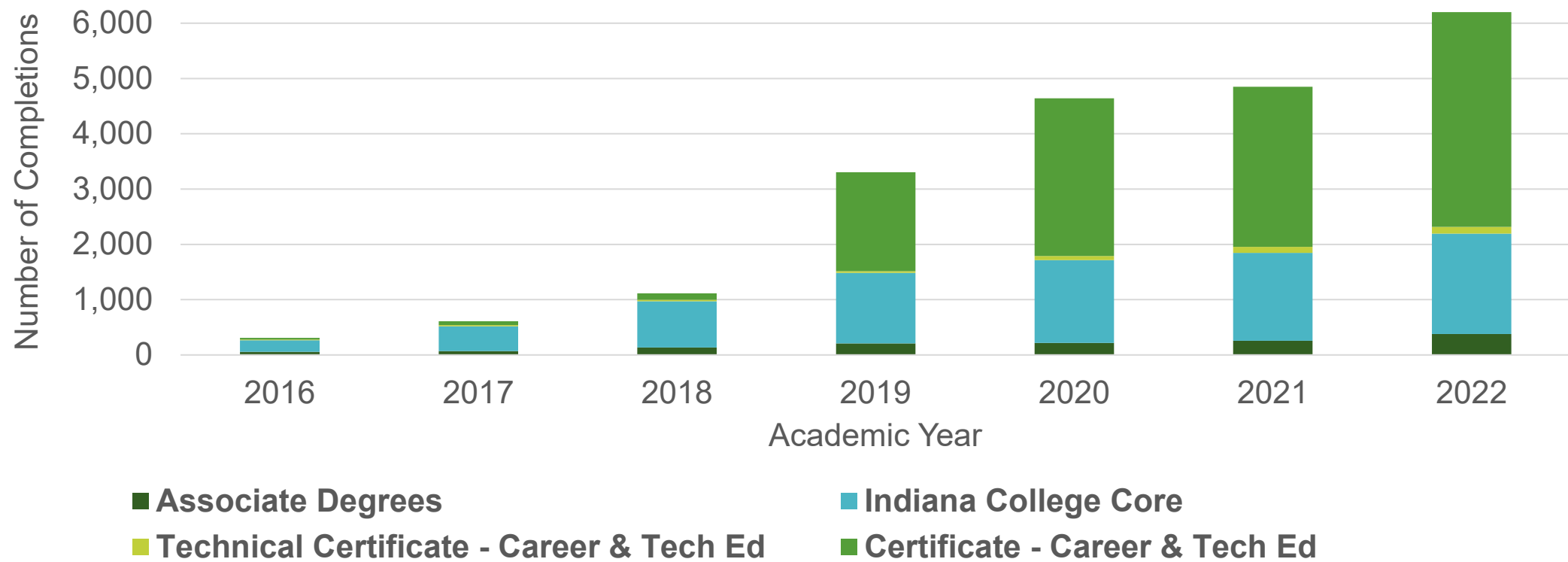
Dual Credit Matters

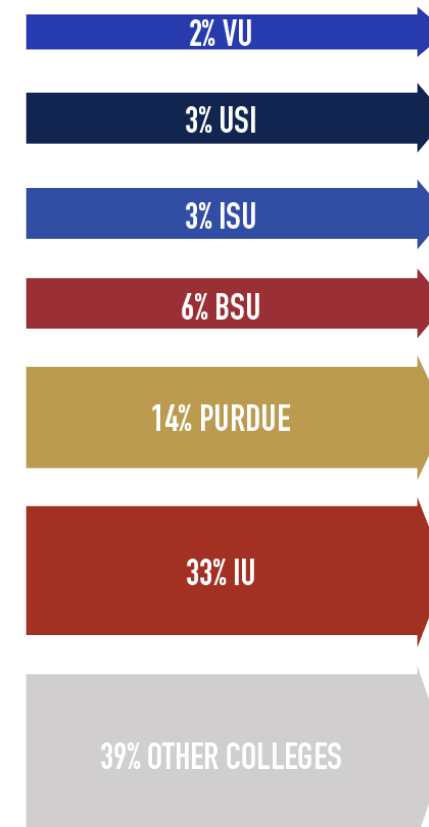

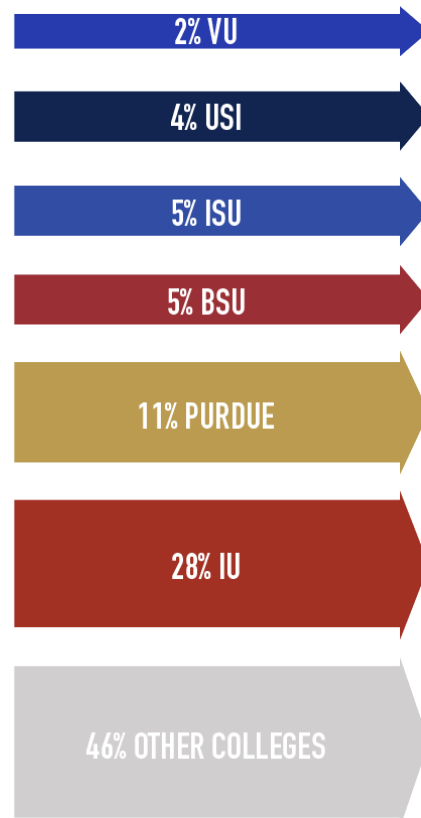

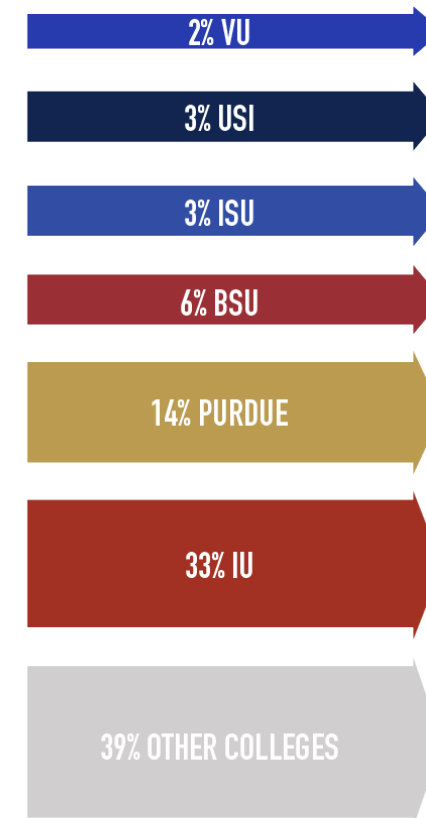

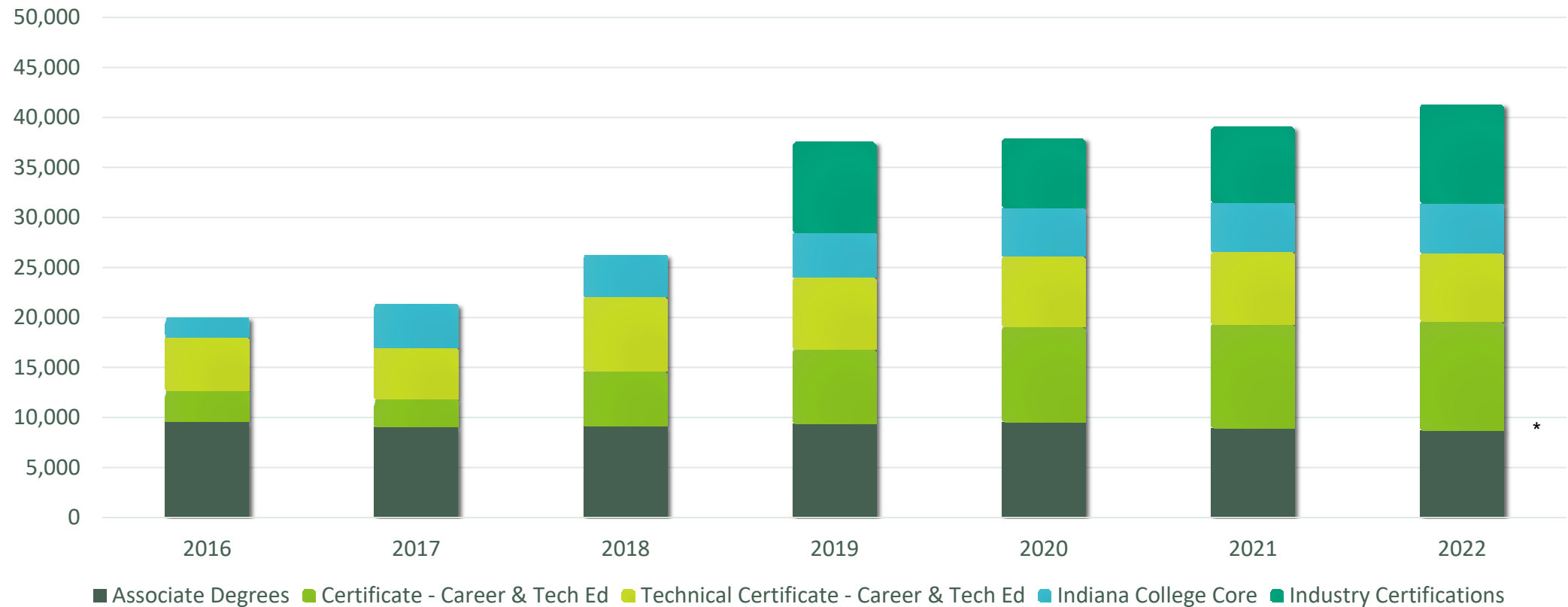

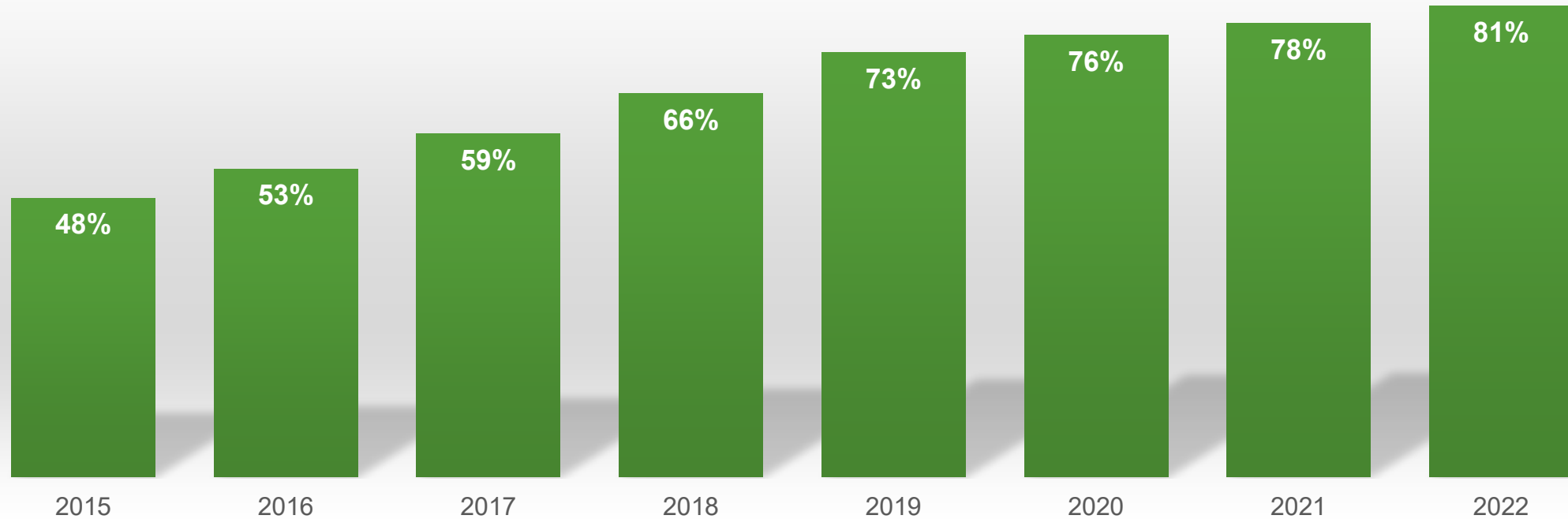
