





Undergraduate Hoosier Enrollment in West Lafayette






Overall Enrollment (No Dual Enrollment)





Purdue Global Hoosier Enrollment





Ten Years with no Tuition Increases at West Lafayette



- At least 60,000 graduates & 8 graduating classes will never experience a tuition increase.
- Today's freshmen were in 3rd grade when Purdue last announced a tuition hike.
- Indiana residents continue to pay less than \$10,000 per year in tuition.



Declining Annual Cost of Attendance at West Lafayette






Debt Per Undergraduate Student: NOMINAL




% Graduating Debt Free




Purdue WL Undergraduates vs. 4-Year Universities

Average Undergraduate Time to Degree Now Less than 4 years










% of Undergraduate Degrees in a STEM Discipline






Purdue Northwest Enrollment (No Dual Enrollment)

Nursing and Pharmacy Education Building




- Building will enable a 10% increase in pharmacy enrollment and a 36% increase in nursing
 - Both programs have grown 20% since 2015
- 70% of nursing graduates practice in Indiana; 2/3 of Indiana pharmacists are Purdue grads
- Will allow consolidation from the 4 spread out buildings, which will be utilized for other growing programs
- \$89 million requested from state; \$71 million already raised by university in gifts and other funds

Purdue in Indianapolis



Assignment of ~28 acres north of Michigan Street

Assignment of ~7 acres including three academic research buildings currently occupied by Purdue

Academic and student success building (lower floors); Estimated cost \$80 million; Plus student housing via P3





Appropriations

- Transition/Start Up Funding: \$10M
- Annual operating: \$17M (Pro-rata reallocation)
