How does the plan achieve the reserve target (5%):

The Lieutenant Governor's Office established the FY26 budget with the new appropriation less the 5% reserve from the start. The 5% reserve is removed from availability for the operating expenses.

Our plan to comply with policies in the FMC:

The Lieutenant Governor's Office works closely with our assigned SBA Analyst on a frequent basis.

Any cost savings identified:

Yes. The amount of External Services expense was reduced drastically from \$817,550 to \$165,000 by discontinuing contracts.

Opportunities to prioritize federal spending rather than state funding: None at this time.

Anticipated federal grant opportunities or renewals:

None at this time.





Staffing Plan:

The Lieutenant Governor's Executive Office consists of a team that prioritizes overseeing statutory duties for the Lieutenant Governor, communication from the office, and providing excellent service to Hoosiers.

The Lieutenant Governor's Office also includes a centralized Business Office that provides shared services to the Executive Office and to the agencies in the Lieutenant Governor's purview: ISDA and OCRA. These services include grant administration, financial management, travel, office management, purchasing, human resources, and IT support.

Analysis of Open Contracts:

The first quarter of calendar year 2025 was spent assessing open contracts. We renegotiated pricing for one contract to reduce the cost over \$15,000. Many other contracts were not renewed.
