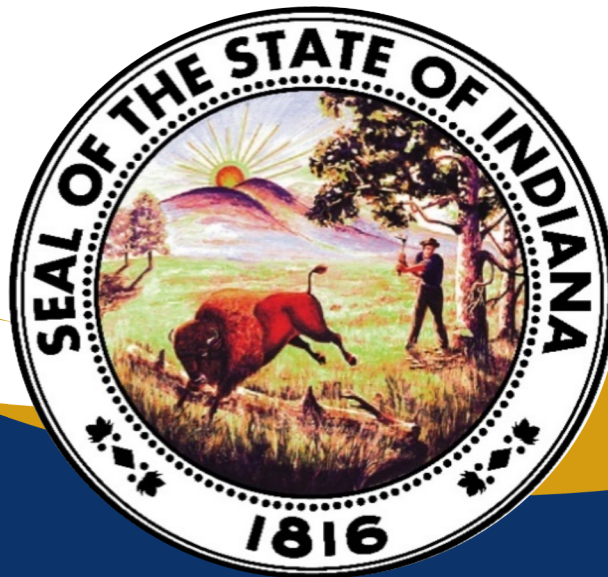

INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANT'S REPORT

To the Indiana State Board of Accounts and
Management of the Liberty Regional Wastewater District

We have examined the Liberty Regional Wastewater District ("District") compliance with the Indiana State Board of Accounts' *Accounting and Uniform Compliance Guidelines Manual For Special Districts* during the period January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2023. Management of the District is responsible for the District's compliance with the specified requirements. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the District's compliance with the specified requirements based on our examination.

Our examination was conducted in accordance with attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. Those standards require that we plan and perform the examination to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the District complied, in all material respects, with the specified requirements referenced above. An examination involves performing procedures to obtain evidence about whether the District complied with the specified requirements. The nature, timing, and extent of the procedures selected depend on our judgment, including an assessment of the risks of material noncompliance, whether due to fraud or error. We believe that the evidence we obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a reasonable basis for our qualified opinion.

We are required to be independent and to meet our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with relevant ethical requirements relating to the engagement.

Our examination does not provide a legal determination on the Unit's compliance with specified requirements.

Our examination disclosed material noncompliance with the *Accounting and Uniform Compliance Guidelines Manual For Special Districts* applicable to the District during the period of January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2023, as described in item 2023-001 on the following Schedule of Examination Findings and Results.

In our opinion, except for the material noncompliance described in the preceding paragraph, the District complied, in all material respects, with the aforementioned requirements during the period of January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2023.

FINDING 2023-001: SCHEDULES IN ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT – CAPITAL ASSETS

Criteria: Indiana Code 5-11-1-4(a) states, *"The state examiner shall require from every municipality and every state or local governmental unit, entity, or instrumentality financial reports covering the full period of each fiscal year. These reports shall be prepared, verified, and filed with the state examiner not later than sixty (60) days after the close of each fiscal year. The reports must be in the form and content prescribed by the state examiner and filed electronically in the manner prescribed under IC 5-14-3.8-7."*

Condition: During our examination procedures, we noted the Schedule of Capital Assets in the Annual Financial Report, as reported on the Indiana Gateway for Government Units financial reporting system, contained errors. The District reported \$11,965,469 in capital assets which did not agree to the underlying capital asset ledger amount of \$11,034,859.
