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INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANT'S REPORT

TO: THE OFFICIALS OF THE INDIANA HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

We have reviewed the activities related to the receipts, disbursements, and assets of the Indiana House of Representatives for the period of July 1, 2008 to April 30, 2012. Indiana House of Representatives' management is responsible for the receipts, disbursements, and assets.

Our review was conducted in accordance with attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. A review is substantially less in scope than an examination, the objective of which is the expression of an opinion on the receipts, disbursements, and assets. Accordingly, we do not express such an opinion.

Financial transactions of this office are included in the scope of our audits of the State of Indiana as reflected in the Indiana Comprehensive Annual Financial Reports. Federal programs are included in the scope of our statewide single audits as reflected in the Statewide Single Audit Reports.

Based on our review, nothing came to our attention that caused us to believe that the activities related to the receipts, disbursements, and assets of the Indiana House of Representatives are not in all material respects in conformity with the criteria set forth in the Accounting and Uniform Compliance Guidelines Manual for State and Quasi Agencies, and applicable laws and regulations.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Indiana House of Representatives' management, and others within the entity, and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties. In accordance with Indiana Code 5-11-5-1, this report is a part of the public records of the State Board of Accounts and of the office reviewed.
