Indiana Statewide 911 Board

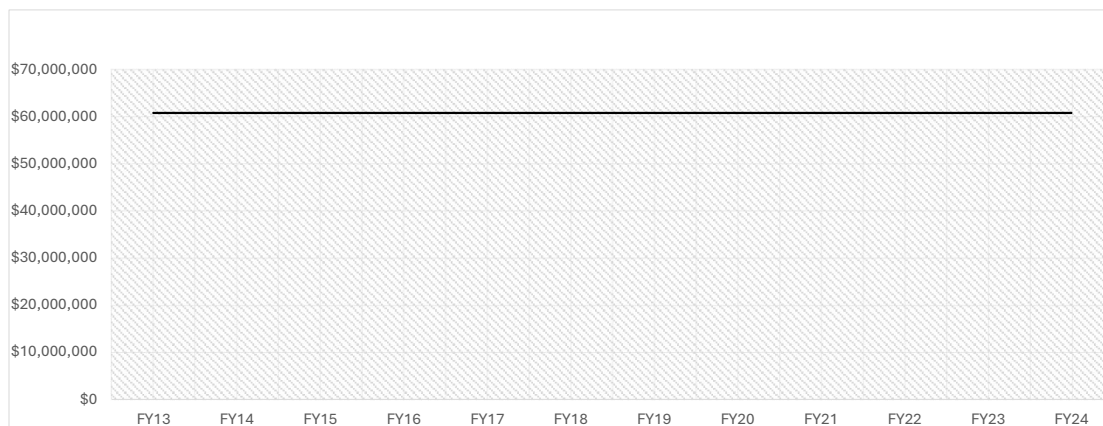
- Established under IC 36-8-16.7, the Indiana Statewide 911 Board ensures that the state's 911 system remains modern, reliable, and responsive. The Board provides:
 - Strategic funding
 - Oversight and accountability
 - Operational and technical support
 - Innovation in 911 service delivery

Hold Harmless

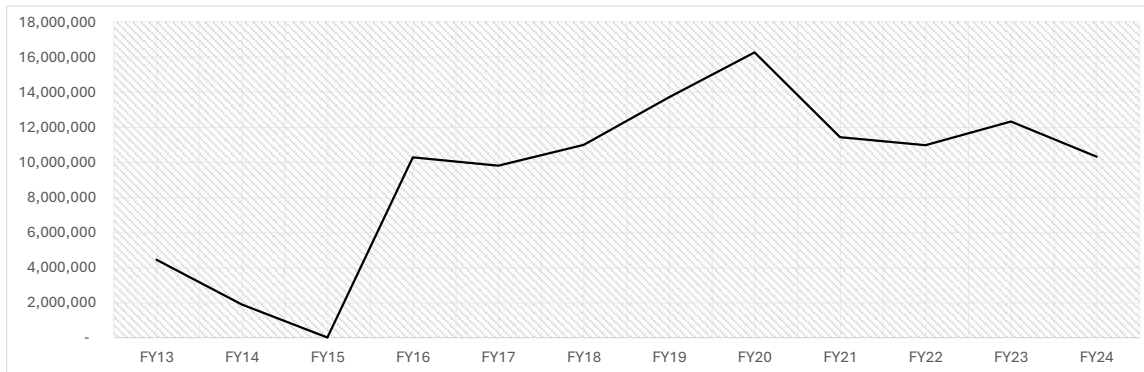
- Guarantees at least 2014 funding levels for each PSAP
 - Benefits small/rural PSAPs
 - No increases for inflation

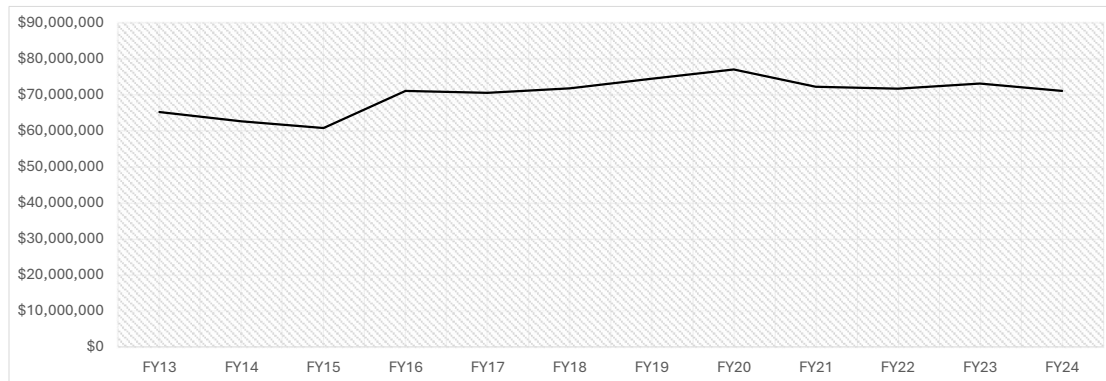
90/10

- 90% by population
- 10% equally split across 92 counties
- Based on year-end surplus
- Not guaranteed
- Should not be counted on as guaranteed revenue
