OVERVIEW: When the Indiana State Board of Education ("Board") adopts rules pursuant to the regular rulemaking process, they are effective for seven (7) years unless the Board submits a request to the Legislative Services Agency to readopt the rules for another seven (7) years. The rule readoption process includes:

- Each year the Legislative Services Agency sends Board staff a list of Board rules set to expire the following year;
- Board staff then review the rules set to expire to determine if they should be readopted or let to expire, and provides a recommendation to the Board;
- The Board votes to approve a list of those rules it wants to readopt and staff publishes this list;
- A 35 day waiting period is triggered for public comment;
- The rules come back to the Board for final approval, after considering public comments (comments are rare).
- Board staff files a Final Notice of Readoption with LSA and the rules are readopted.

The list of rules set to expire this coming January and staff recommendations are as follows:
