**RE:** **Initiate Rulemaking – HEA 1003 Teacher Training Requirements**

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## MEMORANDUM

**Recommendation: Amend 511 IAC 14 and 511 IAC 15 to account for statutory changes made during the 2020 legislative session.**

State Board of Education (“Board”) staff recommends the Board initiate rulemaking to amend 511 IAC 14 (Initial Practitioner and Practitioner Licenses) and 511 IAC 15 (School Settings and License Content Areas), as the existing administrative rules must be updated to account for statutory changes included in HEA 1003-2020. Once rulemaking is initiated, the process will proceed as follows:

- Staff will file initial paperwork with LSA to let them know we have approval from the Board to initiate the rulemaking process.
- Staff will present a Proposed Rule to the Board for adoption at a later meeting.
- Once adopted by the Board, the Proposed Rule will be published for public comment, and a public hearing will be held.
- The Board will adopt a Final Rule based on public comments received at the hearing and any recommended technical changes from staff.
