**RE:** Approval of Federal SIG Funding for Turnaround Academies

This memorandum outlines board staff recommendations for the allocation of federal 1003 School Improvement Grant (“SIG”) funds for Turnaround Academies during the 2018/2019 school year. After approval of these amounts, each organization or school will submit school-specific 1003 applications to the IDOE. IDOE and SBOE will review the applications to ensure compliance with federal law and sound justification for the distribution of grant funds across schools. Each grant will be approved and available to schools by July 1, 2018.

### Key Changes to Funding Distributions for 18/19:

As outlined in the table below, there is a 6% reduction in the SIG set-aside for the 18/19 school year. As a result of new ESSA regulations that go into effect for the first time during the 18/19 school year, the IDOE was unable to set-aside the same amount of SIG funding as they were able to during the 17/18.

To accommodate for this reduction, Turnaround Academy SIG awards were reduced by an additional 6% to ensure the drop in overall funds was shared across all programs.
