

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TROY Alternative Learning Program Agreement

The TROY Center Alternative Learning Program agrees to:

- provide educational instruction and supervision to students referred by the Smith Green Community School Corporation for the 2018-2019 academic year;
- provide a staff to student ratio of at least 1:10, including at least one licensed teacher on staff at all times
- provide varied/alternative curriculum or instructional methods to help student complete required assignments or agreed upon modified assignments;
- provide grade assignments;
- provide students with feedback and modifications needed to complete assignments;
- forward all documentation to the referring school for course approval if requested;
- assist student in understanding any required timelines for completion of course work to meet high school graduation requirements;
- collaborate with school department head or designee regarding student progress, modifications, etc.

Smith Green Community Schools agree to:

- remit payment by start of each year of service at a rate of \$5,450 per student spot reserved; TROY Center tuition rate is set at \$6,300 for the 2018-2019 school year; Smith Green students are being offered a scholarship to discount the tuition rate increase;
- be the teacher of record meeting highly qualified standards for course approval;
- check on student progress each grading period and collaborate with alternative program staff as frequently as needed to meet ISP goals;
- allow modifications in curriculum that are standards-based;
- allow flexible time for course completion
- collaborate with alternative education teacher regarding student progress, modifications, etc.;
- allow TROY Center students to retain eligibility for extra-curricular events unless otherwise noted in ISP;


Courses must be approved in writing by the school and student prior to implementation. Alternative student's Individual Service Plan (ISP) will include course approval and school department head or designee who will coordinate and issue the course minimum requirements for credit and non-credit courses.

Students appropriate for the TROY Center Alternative program include:

- Students in jeopardy of expulsion or suspension;
- Students not succeeding in the traditional classroom;
- Students not qualifying for other special services; or
- Students whose home/environmental/personal circumstances make it difficult for him/her to attend and complete school.

ISP for credit may be modified at any time with agreement from the student, and/or parent, TROY administrator, and a school administrator.


