The following school corporation requests approval to reallocate funds for loan proceeds that were awarded on August 16, 2023, in the amount of \$667,640. No additional funds are being requested. The school requests to reallocate funds in the amount of \$164,056 originally designated for Chromebook and Hot Spot purchases at various buildings throughout the district to help fund the following projects:

- Elementary School Chromebooks \$46,800.00
- Middle School Chromebook Lease Payment \$57,857.73
