ANNUAL PERFORMANCE REPORT

Pursuant to IC 20-20-8-3(a), each school corporation must publish an annual performance report (APR) for the corporation once annually between March 15th and March 31st. The APR is required to be published in a local newspaper of general circulation. The Department must also publish the APR for each school corporation on the Department's website.

The Office of Accountability compiled the required data points for the APR, and released the final version of the 2016 APR to school corporations on March 15, 2017. The APR was made available to schools via DOEOnline and the Department's "Compass" website. All school corporations were given two weeks to review their 2016 APR before its final release. Board members and the public may access a corporation's 2016 APR at <u>www.compass.doe.in.gov</u>, under "Accountability".

On March 27, 2017, the Department released the disaggregated 2016 APR for schools, including charter schools, in Marion County in compliance with IC 20-20-8-8(b). The expanded report is not required to be published in a local newspaper; however, Board members and the public may access the expanded 2016 APR for Marion County schools at www.compass.doe.in.gov, under "Accountability".
