Subject: Common school loan amendment

Taylor Community School Corporation (3460) –

The following school corporation requests approval for an extension of the reimbursement deadline for the 2021 common school technology loan proceeds that were awarded on May 5, 2021, in the amount of \$122,700. The school requests to submit for reimbursement \$118,600.42 for expenses incurred during the allowable time frame.

The original project included:

- 40 Computers for PLTW computer lab
- 2 3D Printers
- 8 Drones/Robotics
- 2 Smartboards and Furniture
- Miscellaneous Hardware and Infrastructure
- Professional Staff Development

All projects are at the high school/middle school.

Administrative policies for the common school fund as adopted on June 7, 2017, indicate technology advances must be used within one year after the State Board of Education approves the advance. A six month extension of this deadline was granted by the State Board of Education on July 7, 2021, due to supply chain issues caused by the COVID pandemic. No additional funds are being requested.

Although school corporation officials did not timely submit reimbursement requests with the state, we request approval for the school to receive state reimbursement from the common school fund for expenditures made within the appropriate time frame.
