RE: Amend 511 IAC 6-7.1 Graduation Requirements for Students Who Begin High School in the 2006-2007 School Year or a Subsequent Year School

MEMORANDUM

Recommendation: amend 511 IAC 6-7.1 to account for provisions contained in P.L. 192-2018.

The State Board of Education (“Board”) staff recommend the Board amend 511 IAC 6-7.1 (Graduation Requirements for Students Who Begin High School in the 2006-2007 School Year or a Subsequent Year School) as the existing administrative rules need to be updated to account for changes necessitated by the adoption of P.L. 192-2018. The Board will not be approving any language at this meeting, merely granting the Board staff permission to begin the rulemaking process. The process will proceed as follows:

- Staff will file initial paperwork with LSA to let them know we have approval from the Board to begin the rulemaking process.
- Staff will present a Proposed Rule to the Board for adoption at a later meeting.
- Once a Proposed Rule is adopted by the Board, it will be published for public comment, and a public hearing will be held.
- The Board will then adopt a Final Rule based on public comments and any recommended technical changes from staff.
