REQUIRED FOR 21ST CENTURY SCHOLARS, RECOMMENDED FOR ALL STUDENTS.



The Scholar Success Program includes activities that will help you stay on track for college and career success.

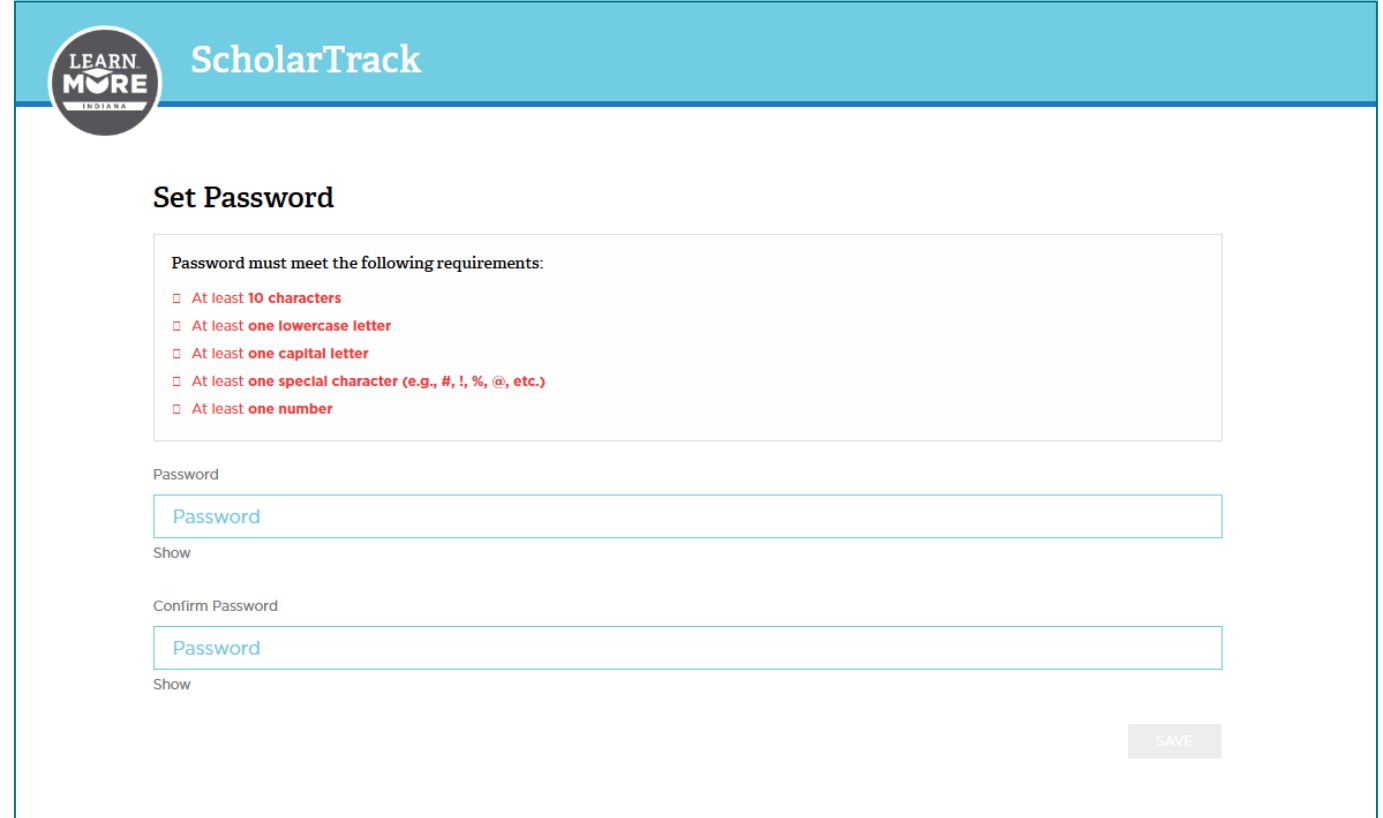

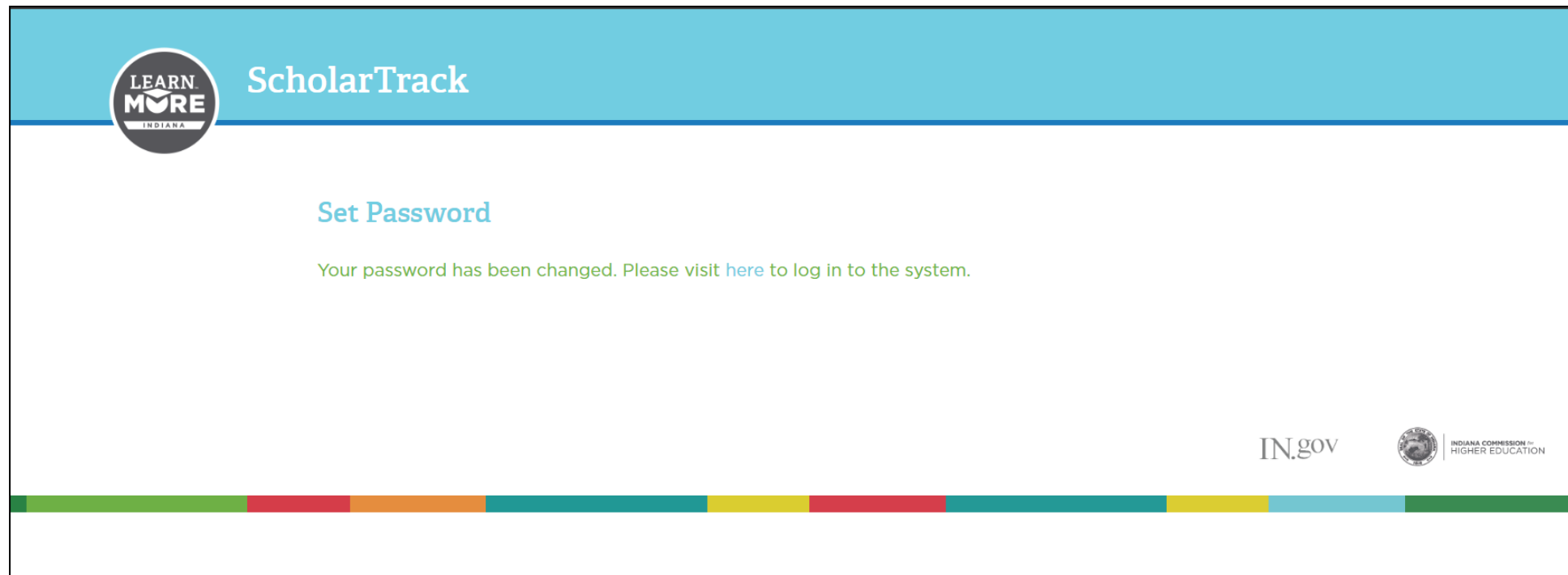

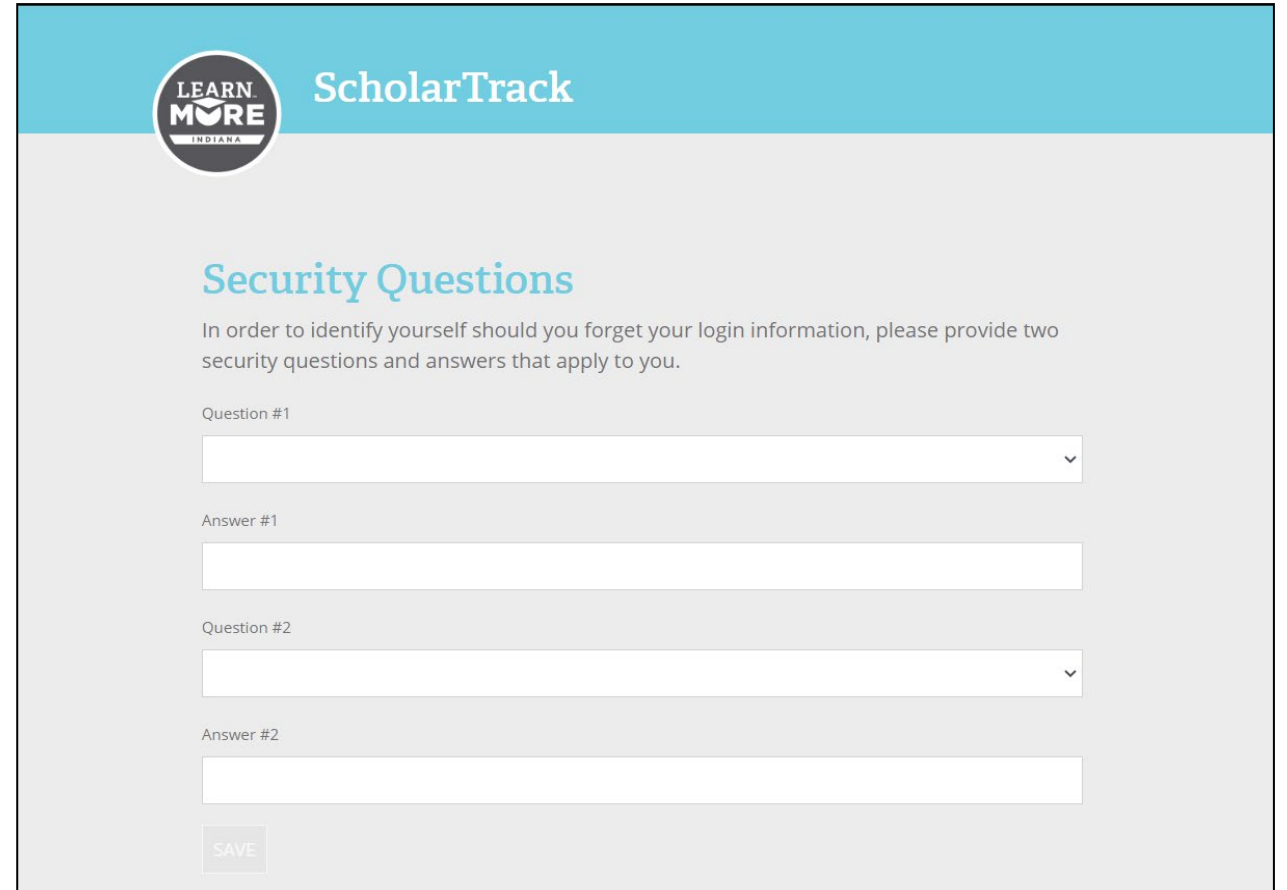

STEP 3 *(for 21st Century Scholars only):* READ AND ACCEPT SCHOLAR PLEDGE

- A screen should pop up with the Scholar Pledge
 - *Required to be eligible for the scholarship*
- Read it and if you agree to the pledge, click “AGREE”

Please accept the terms of the Scholar Pledge below:

Graduate from an accredited high school with a minimum of a Core 40 diploma and a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.

Complete the [Scholars Success Program](#) in high school, which includes activities at each grade level to help me plan, prepare and pay for college.

Not use illegal drugs, commit a crime or delinquent act, or consume alcohol before reaching the legal drinking age.

File the FAFSA by April 15 as a high school senior and each year thereafter until I graduate from college.

Enroll in an eligible Indiana college as a full-time student within one year of high school graduation.

Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress standards established by my college.

Complete 30 credit hours each year I am in college to stay on track toward earning my degree on time.

I understand that I must be an Indiana resident (as determined by the permanent resident of my parent or legal guardian), a U.S. citizen or [eligible non-citizen](#), and meet all other eligibility requirements. I acknowledge and understand that I must be [Title IV](#) eligible in order to receive 21st Century Scholarship funds. Having a Social Security Number does not automatically mean a student is [Title IV](#) eligible. Failure to be [Title IV](#) eligible by April 15th of your senior year of high school automatically disqualifies you from receiving the 21st Century Scholarship.
