The Clinton Prairie High School Flight Number 1961-1962 took off on Tuesday, August 29, 1961, at 8:50 A. M. for the maiden voyage of the newly constructed airship. The crew had been briefed and thoroughly instructed the preceding day as to take-off policies and in-flight instructions for this initial run.

The pilot, co-pilot, and flight supervisor were assisted by 29 instructors, numerous technicians, and ground crew members for this extensive journey which carried an average passenger list of approximately 540 people. The following pages will give a pictorial review of this memorable flight.
