 Chief ALJ Erin McQueen noted that there have been forty-five (45) new cases have been filed so far in 2024. Forty-seven (47) cases are actively pending in various stages of proceedings.

- 4. The oral argument of Petitioner's objections to the Non-Final Order of Gilmour v. DCS, SEAC No. 11-22-044, was heard by oral argument on Petitioner's timely objections and Respondent's response to the objections. Chief ALJ Erin McQueen provided a Non-Final Order. Petitioner Gilmour appeared by counsel, Mr. Biesecker. Respondent appeared by counsel, Mr. Yates. Both parties provided oral argument. Following public deliberation, the Commission AFFIRMED the ALJ's Non-Final Order by a vote of 4-0. Additionally, the Commission considered Respondent's Motion to Correct Error filed August 01, 2024. The Commission determined that the error in the Non-Final Order was a scrivener's error and ordered that ALJ McQueen issue the Final Order of the Commission with the correction.
- 5. The Commission then selected a Chair and Vice-Chair pursuant to I.C. 4-15-1.5-5. Commissioner Frank Sullivan Jr. was selected to be retained by the Commission members as the Chair of the Commission. Commissioner Veronica Hubartt was selected to be retained by the members of the Commission as the Vice-Chair of the Commission.
- 6. Seeing no further new business, Chair Sullivan closed the meeting at 02:50 P.M. with the next meeting Commission Meeting date TBD.
