#### FY22: What's Changed

- ALL FORMULA applications will initially be submitted to <u>info@serveindiana.gov</u> via Word & Excel
   Documents. Once you have been invited to move forward in the application process you will be asked to
   input your application into the eGrants system at that time.
- Serve Indiana added a notice of intent to apply for Continuation applicants: February 1, 2022.
- Added a table of contents
- Added the focus areas
- o Funding priorities: added Programs that prioritize civic engagement & social cohesion
- Living allowance: minimum FT member living allowance is \$16,502. Serve Indiana has also implemented a minimum living allowance for every slot type. Please see slide 3 for additional information.
- Cost per MSY: maximum cost per MSY is \$28,800. Minimum request is \$21,600
- Narrative: Program Design-added additional information. Refer to slides 5-10 for additional information
- Formula programs may increase the Narrative section to 11 pages to account for the additional information as noted above.

#### Cost per MSY

- o Formula programs may request a minimum of \$21,600 to a maximum of \$28,800 per MSY.
- EAP programs may request a minimum of \$800 per MSY to a maximum of \$1,000 per MSY.
- Serve Indiana encourages all programs to try and request up to the maximum cost per MSY, however we
  will also be closely monitoring to ensure that programs are spending all dollars. Serve Indiana has the
  right to request a program to lower their cost per MSY.

### Living Allowance

OServe Indiana has implemented a change in the Living Allowance requirements. To ensure all members receive a living allowance, beginning in the 2022-2023 PY Serve Indiana will require a minimum living allowance for all slot types. Please see the table below.
