Navigating Medicare

November, 2025

Q: With the end of the year coming, I am working on my 2026 budget. What can I expect to pay in Medicare premiums and deductibles in 2026?

A: The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) have just released the 2026 premiums, deductibles, and coinsurance amounts for the Medicare Part A and Part B programs, and the 2026

Medicare Part D incomerelated monthly adjustment amounts. There will be increases in Medicare Part A and Part B premiums and a slight decrease in the maximum out-of-pocket limit to income-related premium surcharges for Medicare Part

for Medicare Advantage plans. There will also be adjustments B and Part D.

Medicare beneficiaries will want to be proactive during this Medicare Open Enrollment Period (Oct. 15-Dec. 7), as comparing plans from multiple insurers can help them find the right option for them, saving them money in 2026.

The Medicare Plan Finder helps you compare plans in your area and compare their specific monthly premiums, deductibles and copayments. You can find it at medicare.gov/plan-compare.
