## **Notice of Public Hearing**

Under IC 4-22-2-23, notice is hereby given that on April 25th, at 10:00 a.m.at the Indiana Government Center South, 302 West Washington Street, Conference Room D, Indianapolis, Indiana, the Secretary of State – Business Services (division) will hold a public hearing on adding rules at 75 IAC 10 concerning the Enhanced Access ("EA") fees authorized by IC 4-5-10-2 for UCC related services. UCC EA Fees are collected in lieu of statutory paper filing fees pursuant to IC 26-1-9.1-525. This rulemaking establishes in rule the exact EA fees already being collected by the division for online UCC transactions. These are not new fees but are simply the promulgation in rule of already established existing fees. As no changes in fees are being made, no impact is expected for online UCC customers. Online UCC services are primarily utilized by UCC service providers, financial institutions, and law firms.

The purpose of this hearing is to receive comments from the public prior to consideration of adoption of these rules by the division. All interested persons are invited and will be given reasonable opportunity to express their views concerning the proposed rules.

If the division does not receive substantive comments during the public comment period or public hearing, the rule may be adopted with text that is the same as or does not substantially differ from the proposed rule.
