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In preparation for the launch of the Electronic Lien & Title (ELT) program, the Titles Department has revised the following forms:

[State Form 205 – Application for Certificate of Title for a Vehicle](#) – Revision (R11 / 3-20)  
[State Form 38529 – Application for Certificate of Watercraft Title](#) – Revision (R10 / 10-21)

The revised versions of these forms contain a field to capture an Electronic Lien & Title (ELT) Identification Number, also referred to as an ELT ID. The ELT ID is required to identify and accurately record a lien for a lienholder that is participating in the ELT program.

Effective July 1, 2022, title applications with an ELT lien must use the revised forms linked above. Transactions with no lien, or for Non-ELT lienholders, will be required to use the forms linked above effective October 1, 2022.
