Hancock County Election Board Resolution No. 2016-06
Amend Vote Center Plan – Update Poll Worker Title and Number per Center

Whereas, the IC 3-11-18.1-15 allows the local Election Board to amend the county's vote center plan; and,

Whereas, the Hancock County Election Board has determined it is in the interest of the citizens of Hancock County to properly update the plan as needed; and,

Whereas, the timeframe for adopting this resolution is not prescribed in statute; but rather becomes effective upon the unanimous vote of the entire membership;

Now, therefore, be it resolved pursuant IC 3-11-18.1-15 the Hancock County Election Board, by unanimous vote of the board's entire membership, amends the vote center plan to update the paragraph titled "Poll Workers" on page 24 of the original plan by deleting the last sentence thereof in its entirety and the third sentence thereof and replacing it with the following:

"Each early or satellite Vote Center will have at least one traditional precinct election board made up of Poll Workers who shall have the Title of: Inspector, Judge Opposite and Election Assistant . The Inspector and Judge Opposite shall be of different political parties. The duties of said Poll Workers shall be as set out in Resolution No. 2014-01 of the Hancock County Election Board. The minimum number of workers at a Vote Center location shall be no less than 3 regardless of the size of the Vote Center which replaces the maximum number of 6 poll workers at a small location and a maximum of 8 poll workers at a large location."

Further, this resolution shall take effect immediately and may only be rescinded by unanimous vote of the entire membership of the Hancock County Election Board
