

## **Adams County Vote Center Plan 2019 Amendment**

Whereas, the Adams County Vote Center Plan was duly adopted on February 26, 2016;  
and

Whereas, Indiana Code 3-11-18.1-15 authorizes Adams County to amend a plan adopted with a county election board's order under Indiana Code 3-11-18.1-3 by unanimous vote of the entire membership of the board approving the plan amendment;  
and

Whereas, the Adams County Election Board so approves the Adams County Vote Center Plan Amendment for vote centers in Adams County Indiana. This amendment only applies to the November 5, 2019 General Municipal Election in Adams County.

**BE IT THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE ADAMS COUNTY ELECTION BOARD;**

1. The total number of vote centers for the 2019 General Municipal Election will be four.
2. The locations of the four vote centers are as follows;
  - a. First Missionary Church: 950 US Hwy 27 S. Berne, IN.
  - b. Swiss Village (Auditorium): 1350 W. Main St. Berne, IN.
  - c. K of C Hall: 1703 High St. Decatur, IN.
  - d. Bridge Community Church: 1403 Winchester Rd. Decatur, IN.
3. The satellite locations and dates are as follows;
  - a. Bridge Community Church: 1403 Winchester Rd. Decatur, IN 46733  
(The two Saturdays before Election Day- 9:00 am- 4:00 pm)
  - b. First Missionary Church: 950 US Hwy. 27 S. Berne, IN 46711  
(The Tuesday before Election Day- 9:00 am- 4:00 pm)
  - c. Woodcrest: 1300 Mercer Ave. Decatur, IN 46733  
(The Wednesday before Election Day- 10:00 am- 4:00 pm)
  - d. Swiss Village (Auditorium): 1350 W. Main St. Berne, IN 46711  
(The Thursday before Election Day- 12 noon- 8:00 pm)

4. Each vote center location will have 5 poll workers.
  - a. One inspector.
  - b. Two Clerks. One Republican and one Democrat.
  - c. Two Judges. One Republican and one Democrat.
5. Each early voting satellite office locations will have an Absentee Board consisting of two election workers; one from each major political party. Each satellite office will have four voting machines and two electronic poll books.
