

PIKE COUNTY ELECTION BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 2020-04
ESTABLISHING SATELLITE OFFICES FOR ABSENTEE VOTING

2020 GENERAL ELECTION

Recitals

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 3-11-10-26.3 provides that a county election board may adopt a resolution to authorize the circuit court clerk to establish satellite offices in the county where voters may cast absentee ballots before an absentee voter board; and

WHEREAS, the Pike County Election Board has determined that it is in the best interest of the voters of Pike County, Indiana, to have available satellite offices for casting absentee ballots in the 2020 general election; and

WHEREAS, the Pike County Election Board has determined that for the 2020 general election, the following 4 locations shall serve as general election early voting satellite locations:

1. Union Community Building 3082 N Co Rd 850 W Hazelton IN 47640
2. Jordan Memorial Park 11090 S St Rd 61 Spurgeon IN 47584
3. Lockhart Community Center 10581 S Church St Stendal IN 47585
4. Winslow Community Center 301 E Porter St Winslow IN 47598;

and

WHEREAS, the Pike County Election Board has determined that the for the 2020 general election, the following dates and hours are appropriate for absentee voting at each location:

1. Union Community Building - Tuesday, October 13, 3 p.m. - 8 p.m.
2. Jordan Memorial Park - Tuesday, October 20, 3 p.m. - 8 p.m.
3. Lockhart Community Center - Tuesday, October 27, 3 p.m. - 8 p.m.
4. Winslow Community Center - Saturdays, October 24 & 31, 8 a.m. - 12 p.m.;

and

WHEREAS, the Pike County Election Board has determined that the Pike County Clerk's Office should not be required to remain open concurrently with early voting satellite locations in the 2020 general election.

NOW THEREFORE, the Pike County Election Board resolves as follows:

1. The Circuit Court Clerk is authorized and directed to establish satellite offices where voters may cast absentee ballots in the 2020 general election.
2. The 2020 general election satellite offices shall be established at the following locations:
Union Community Building 3082 N Co Rd 850 W Hazelton IN 47640
Jordan Memorial Park 11090 S St Rd 61 Spurgeon IN 47584
Lockhart Community Center 10581 S Church St Stendal IN 47585
Winslow Community Center 301 E Porter St Winslow IN 4759

These locations are known to the Board to be accessible sites.

3. The Pike County Election board has decided that each satellite voting location will receive a rental payment of \$75 each time they are utilized as a satellite voting location. This rental fee will be paid from Election Fund 1215-001-03-3064, Polling Location Rental.
4. The Pike County Clerk's Office, 2nd floor of courthouse, 801 E Main St, Petersburg IN 47567 shall also be open for 2020 general election absentee voting as described in Resolution 2020-03. This location is also known to the Board to be an accessible site.
5. The dates and hours at which absentee voting may occur at the satellite locations for the 2020 general election are as follows:
 - Union Community Building – Tuesday, October 13, 3 p.m. – 8 p.m.
 - Jordan Memorial Park – Tuesday, October 20, 3 p.m. – 8 p.m.
 - Lockhart Community Center – Tuesday, October 27, 3 p.m. – 8 p.m.
 - Winslow Community Center – Saturdays, October 24 & 31, 8 a.m. – 12 p.m.
6. The Pike County Clerk's Office shall not be required to remain open concurrently with early voting satellite locations in the 2020 general election.
7. This resolution shall expire on January 1, 2021.



ORDER ADOPTING VOTE CENTER PLAN AMENDMENT ON SEPTEMBER 3, 2020

WHEREAS, the Pike County Vote Center Plan was duly adopted on March 4, 2020;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 3-11-18.1-15 authorizes Pike County to amend a plan adopted with a county election board's order under 3-11-18.1-3 by unanimous vote of the entire membership of the board approving the plan amendment; and

WHEREAS, the Pike County Election Board so approves the Pike County Vote Center Plan Amendment for vote centers in Pike County Indiana.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE PIKE COUNTY ELECTION BOARD:

The current Vote Center Plan for Pike County lists a precinct election board for each vote center that consists of:

- One (1) Inspector-Political Party that won highest number of votes for the last election of the Secretary of State will fill this position.
- Four (4) Judges- two from each major political party.
- Two (2) Poll Clerks- One from each major political party

The Pike County Election Board has decided by unanimous vote that each vote center precinct election board will consist of:

Gospel Center: Two (2) Inspectors-Political Party that won highest number of votes for the last election of the Secretary of State will fill this position

Two (4) Judges - two from each major political party

Four (4) Poll Clerks - two from each major political party

Otwell Community Center: One (2) Inspectors-Political Party that won highest number of votes for the last election of the Secretary of State will fill this position

Two (4) Judges - two from each major political party

Four (4) Poll Clerks - two from each major political party

Winslow Community Center: One (2) Inspectors-Political Party that won highest number of votes for the last election of the Secretary of State will fill this position

Two (4) Judges - two from each major political party

Four (4) Poll Clerks - two from each major political party

The Pike County Election Board has also decided on the following pay scale by unanimous vote:

Inspectors:	\$275.00	x 6	= \$1,650.00
Democrat Judge:	\$225.00	x 6	= \$1,350.00
Republican Judge:	\$200.00	x 6	= \$1,200.00
Clerks:	\$175.00	x 12	= <u>\$2,100.00</u>
		TOTAL	\$6,300.00

The Election Board of Pike County hereby unanimously adopts the Order to approve this Vote Center Plan Amendment.

Further, this resolution shall take effect immediately and may only be rescinded by unanimous vote of the entire membership of Pike County Election Board.
