INSTRUCTIONS: The chairman of the state central committee of the Democratic or Republican Party (or the chairman's designee) must issue a call for a caucus to nominate a candidate to the special election ballot to fill a congressional vacancy. The chairman or designee must send the notice by first class mail at least ten (10) days before the caucus to all persons eligible to participate in the caucus. The notice must state the time, place, and purpose of the caucus. The chairman or designee must also file a copy of the notice not later than NOON ten (10) days before the caucus with the Indiana Election Division.
